

Saturday Review Poet To Speak at Nazareth

John Ciardi, poetry editor of the Saturday Review of Literature, will lecture on Dante's Divine Comedy at Nazareth College, Monday, March 1, at 8 p.m. The lecture, entitled "The Longest Walk in the Universe," will be one of three programs this semester scheduled in honor of the 70th anniversary of Dante's birth.

In addition to his articles, columns and editorials in the Saturday Review, Ciardi has become well-known as a poet, translator, teacher, editor, lecturer and former host of the CBS TV Network weekly show "Accent," one of television's highly rated discussion programs. He also serves as Director of the Bread Loaf Writers' Conference.

Ciardi is a former Professor of English at Rutgers University. His books of poems include "Homeward to America," "Live Another Day," and "In the Stone Years." His "How Does a Poem Mean?" is widely used in colleges and high schools as an introduction to poetry text. For the last 14 years he has been working on an English version of Dante's "Divine Comedy," of which the "Inferno" and "Purgatorio" have already been published.

Among his more recent literary contributions are two books of poems for children "I Met a Man," which was ranked in fourth place in the New York Times list of best-selling juvenile books and "The Man Who Sang the Sillies," and "John J. Plenty and Fiddler Dan."

Ciardi is the recipient of many literary awards, including the Avery Hopwood Award in Poetry (1939); the Blumenthal Prize, Poetry Magazine (1944); the Eunice Tietjens Award (1945); the Levison Prize (1947); the Harriet Monroe

Father Morphy Compared to Good Shepherd

"We can read his record in many ways," Monsignor George Cocuzzi said in the sermon at the funeral Mass for Father Roy B. Morphy.

The only true record for a priest, however, is to compare him "to the measure of Christ."

And like His Master, Father Morphy met that measure "to be the shepherd of his flock, to know the people, to be able to call them by name, to know their families, to see that each one of them, each individual made in the image and likeness of Almighty God, each individual whom alone and personally Almighty God had called to be His own and to whom Father Morphy had been sent to serve."

Monsignor Cocuzzi developed the parallel between the life of the great Good Shepherd and the life of the pastor of St. Jerome's Church in East Rochester. Full text of the eulogy will be in next week's Courier. Biographical details about Father Morphy were in last week's paper.

Bishop Kearney offered the solemn funeral Mass for Father Morphy Saturday morning. The East Rochester pastor died Sunday, Feb. 14, 1965.

Attending the Mass were the Rt. Rev. Monsignors Wilfred T. Craugh, John A. Ball, John S. Randall, William J. Naughton, A. J. Schneider, Arthur Ratican, John Toomey, Very Rev. Msgr. Emmett Murphy and more than 85 priests.

Nuns and lay people filled the parish church to capacity for the funeral rites.
