### Notre Dame Tops Seton, Eyes Tourney Foe

Elmira—The first half of the Notre Dame-Seton game was a low-scoring, tight defensive battle. At no time could either team pull away for more than a four-point lead.

The rebounding of Mike Malone and Jim Merriam kept Notre Dame in control of the ball. Although their shooting percentage was low, the excellent ball control kept them on top.

The soft touch jump-shot of Seton's star forwards kept them close behind throughout the first half. The score at the beginning of the second quarter was 16-12 in Notre Dame's favor.

Seton quickly moved ahead by one. From then on, neither team could get more than a two-point lead.

Dan McCarthy's ball handling kept Seton's full-court press from becoming effective. Again, Notre Dame's rebounding advantage and Seton's fine shooting kept the game close.

As the game progressed into the third quarter Notre Dame's lead lengthened by seven points. Throughout the quarter, husky Mike Malone kept Notre Dame in front with his outstanding work under the boards. At the end of three quarters the score was Notre Dame, 43; Seton, 30.

As the fourth quarter progressed, Seton resorted to a fast break to try to close the gap of 13 points. This strategy paid off for a time, but Notre Dame again built up their leads. The great floorplay of sophomore Dan McCarthy, the rebounding of Mike Malone, and the deceptive drives of Bill Huddle sparked the Crusader's drive.

Notre Dame ended their regularly scheduled season with the final 60-46 win over Seton. However, the season will continue when the Crusaders meet Mt. Carmel in the Rochester Invitational Tournament on Friday, March 5.
