# Hornell Holding Pre-Cana Talks

Hornell — Two afternoon conferences for persons planning to be married will be presented under sponsorship of the Catholic Family Groups of St. Ann's Church this month.

The first pre-Cana conference was given on Sunday, Mar. 14 at 2 p.m. in St. Ann's School hall. It will be followed by another on March 21.

Talks by a priest, one or more members of the medical profession and laymen well versed in some special aspect of the Sacrament of Matrimony keynote each of the meetings. These talks are followed by informal discussions, and question and answer sessions over coffee.

The Rev. Frederick F. Eismann, moderator of the Catholic Family Movement in St. Ann's, emphasized today that the conferences are open to all persons contemplating marriage regardless of their faith.

He outlined the general purpose of the conferences which is to prepare engaged couples for holy and happy marriage and stable family life, by sound instructional and accurate information.

"God's plan for love and marriage is the general theme," he said. "We hope, through these discussions, to analyze with the couples what married life naturally and properly should be and to propose suggestions as to how this ideal might be realized," he said.

The conferences began with a talk by a priest on marriage as a sacrament and as a vocation. The opening discussion, "The Priest Looks at Marriage," outlined the attitude of the Catholic Church on Matrimony. Later, married physiology and psychology were discussed as "The Doctor Looks at Marriage."

Personal experiences and problems which arise in married life will be related by laymen in the Mar. 21 session which will begin with "The Couples Speak on Marriage."

"Our Wedding Day," an explanation of the ceremonies and the spiritual significance of the day will follow.
