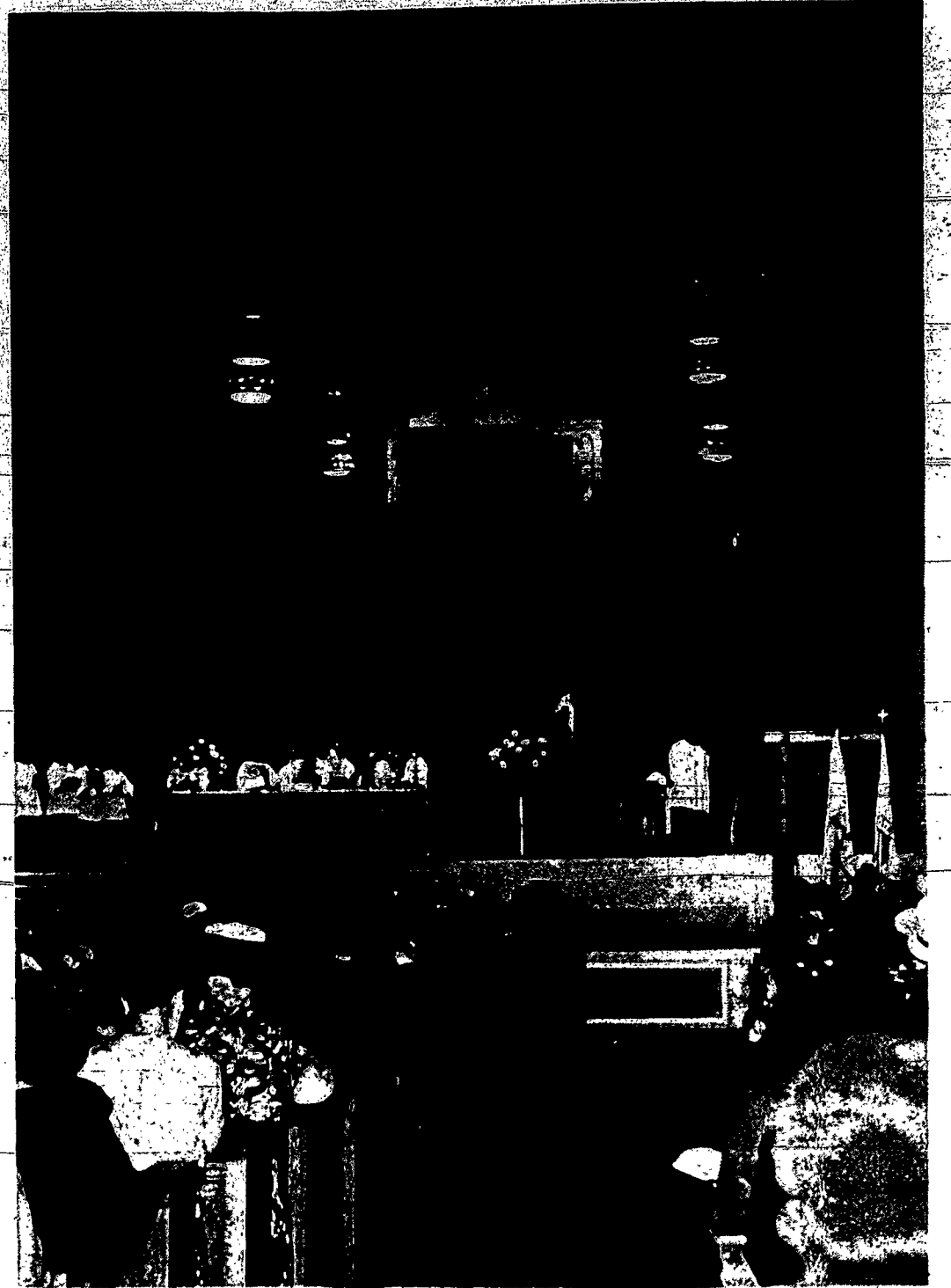

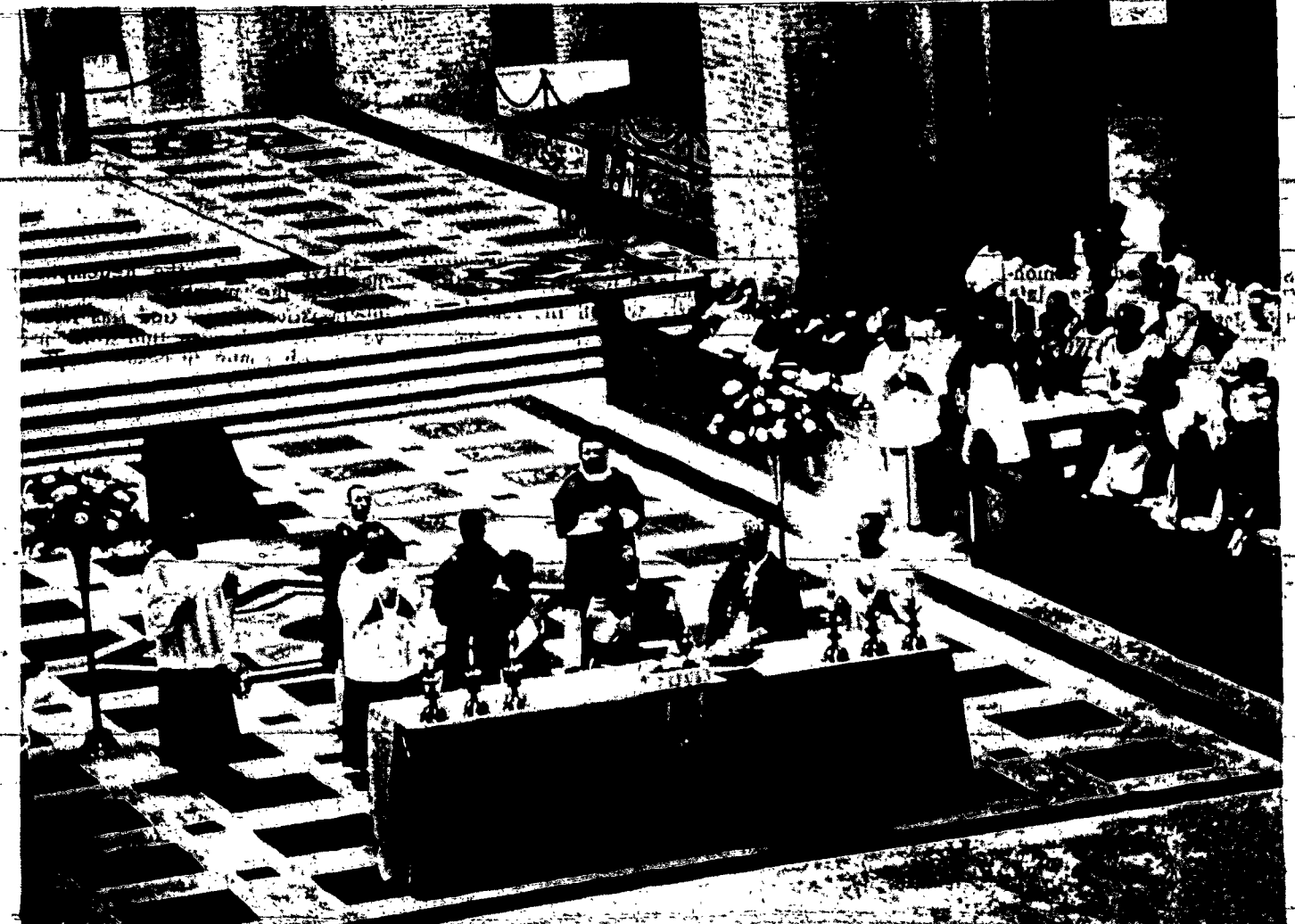

Scholars Study Doctrine on Mary

Santo Domingo — (RNS) — A special service of invocation to the Holy Spirit in the 16th Century cathedral where the remains of Christopher Columbus are preserved marked the opening here of the fourth International Mariological Congress.

The congress theme was "Mary in the Scriptures." This meant that the theologians and exegetes would discuss the Scriptural foundations of Marian theology and devotion during five-day sessions held in the National Assembly of the Congressional Hall.

The Mariological Congress was to be followed by the eleventh Marian Congress, an event intended publicly to express Catholic devotion to the Blessed Virgin. Attending the Marian Congress, it was announced, would be delegates to the Mariological Congress and large numbers of bishops, clergy, religious and faithful. Among the scheduled highlights was the dedication of the National Shrine at Higüey dedicated to Our Lady of Grace, patroness of the Dominican people; a torchlight procession, programs of sacred music by a Spanish choir, and homilies by leading Catholic preachers from around the world.

The U.S. participants included Father Eugene H. Maly of Mount St. Mary's Seminary, Cincinnati, an official Vatican Council theologian; Father Richard Kugelmann, C.P., of Union City, N.J.; and Father Eamon R. Carroll, O. Carm., assistant professor of sacred theology at the Catholic University of America, Washington, D.C., one of America's leading scholars in Mariology.

Among the Non-Catholic participants was a delegate of the Protestant monastic community at Taizé, France.
