

## Funeral Held For Father Racaitis

Solemn funeral Mass was offered for Rev. Antanas S. Racaitis at St. George's Lithuanian Church Thursday, April 1.

Father Racaitis died Monday, March 20, 1965. He was 55.

Bishop Kearney said the Requiem Mass and Rev. Frank Valukievicius gave the eulogy.

Father Racaitis, despite a life marked by many hardships, was well known in the Lithuanian community for his cheerful and friendly attitude.

He was a refugee from his homeland, now under Communist control, arrested by the Russians but escaped to the U.S. zone in Germany. He was detained in the notorious displaced persons camps of Europe where he served the DPs in their anguished waiting for freedom.

Friends in Rochester invited him here and Bishop Kearney welcomed him to be a priest of the Diocese.

Prior to his coming to Rochester, Father Racaitis taught in schools in West Germany and served parishes in Pennsylvania and Illinois. He was ordained in Lithuania in 1936 and came to Rochester in 1956.

Rev. Raymond Wuest was deacon at the funeral Mass and Rev. Bernard Kuchman was subdeacon. Additional details will be in next week's Courier.

## Nuns' Marching Wins Approval

Nerinx, Ky.—(NC)—A prominent U.S. Sister said here she supports the participation of nuns in the Selma protest marches and in the sympathy demonstrations held elsewhere in the country.

Sister Mary Luke said she rated the nuns' presence as "very much in line with the pastoral concerns of the Church."

Sister Luke is superior-general of the Sisters of Loretto, whose motherhouse is here. She is also chairman of the Conference of Major Superiors of Women's Religious Communities and was the first U.S. woman auditor at the Vatican Council.

Asked if she rated participation by the Sisters as incompatible with the religious state, she responded: "Heavens, no. I know the nuns who took part have gotten letters of protest. Some people say they have sullied their habits and so forth.

"But I think it shows Sisters as deeply concerned with human dignity and human rights and I think this is very fine. Sisters have every reason to be very much concerned with anything that has to do with human misery and human needs."

New Orleans — (RNS) — Episcopal Bishop Graul, M. Jones of Louisiana said here that the divisions of Christendom "must be acknowledged to be one of the scandals of history."

## Father Hurley Funeral Saturday

Solemn funeral Mass will be offered for Rev. Victor J. Hurley at the Chapel at St. Ann's Home Saturday, April 3, at 10 a.m.

Auxiliary Bishop Lawrence B. Casey will say the Mass. Rev. Howard Geck will preach the eulogy.

**FATHER HURLEY**, 79, died Wednesday, March 31, 1965. He had retired from active pastoral duties in 1944 after serving as chaplain at St. Ann's Home since 1939.

Most of his life was marked by frail health but he left an impact of quiet devotion in the

parishes he served since his ordination in 1912.

He is survived by a sister, Mrs. George Kohlman of Rochester.

Father Hurley born February 19, 1886, is the son of the late John and Elizabeth Fagan Hurley of Rochester. He attended St. Patrick's Cathedral school, St. Andrew's and St. Bernard's seminaries.

Following ordination, he was assigned as assistant pastor of St. Patrick's Cathedral and later the same year (1912) served as administrator of St. Rose Church, Lima. He was an assist-

ant pastor at Immaculate Conception Church, Rochester, until 1913; St. Mary's Church, Auburn, 1913 to 1915; Holy Cross Church, Ovid, 1915 to 1917; Immaculate Conception Church, Ithaca, 1917 to 1918; Blessed Sacrament Church, Rochester, 1918.

He was then named pastor of the Church of the Good Shepherd, Henrietta, and St. Catherine's Church, Mendon, a pastorate he held for 21 years.

During that time he purchased a house to serve as a rectory and later arranged for St. Catherine's to be served
