Nerinx, Ky.-(NC)-A promi nent U.S. Sister said here she supports the participation of nuns in the Selma protest marches and in the sympathy demonstrations held elsewhere in the country.

Sister Mary Luke said she rated the nuns' presence as 'very much in line with the pastoral concerns of the Church.

Sister Luke is superior general of the Sisters of Loretto, whose-motherhouse is here. She is also chairman of the Confererace of Major Superiors of Women's Religious Communities and was the first U.S. woman auditor at the Vatican

Asked if she rated participatible with the religious state, she responded: "Heavens, no. I know the nuns who took part have gotten letters of protest. Some people say they have sullied their habits and so forth.

"But I think it shows Sisters as deeply concerned with human dignity and human rights and I think this is very fine. Sisters have every reason to be very much concerned with anything that has to do with human misery and human needs."
