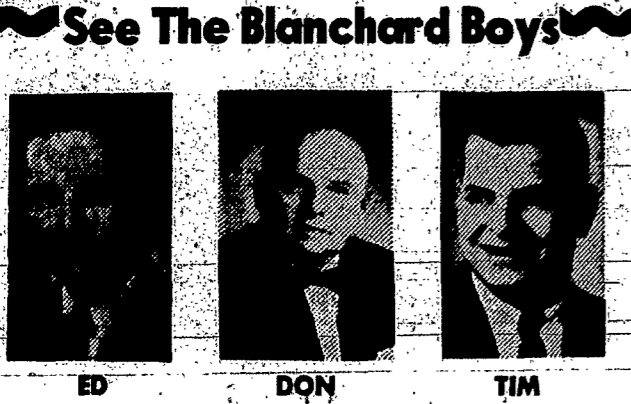

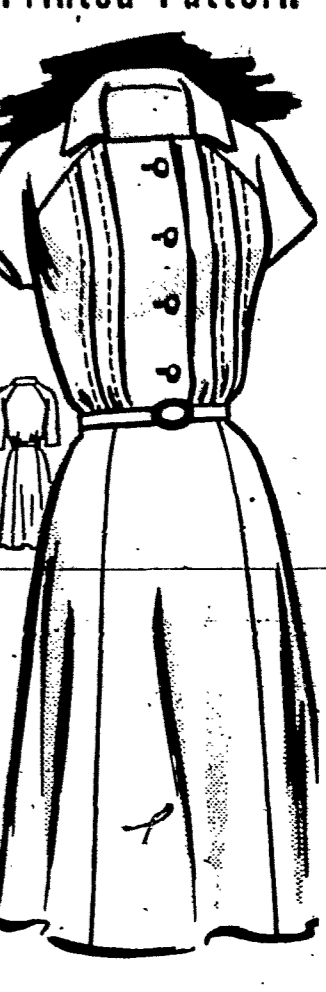

**Globetrotters Return To War Memorial Court**

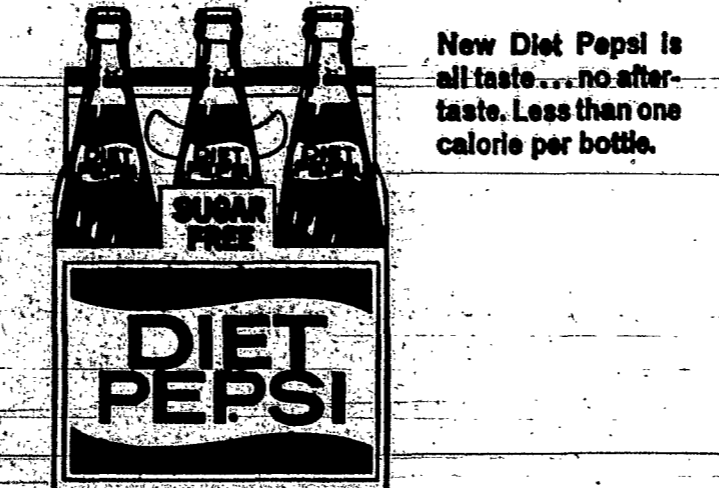
