Sister's Flag Flutters Atop Peak In Andes
Buenos Aires—(NC)—A tiny blue pennant made by the Sisters of Providence in Everett, Wash., flutters today atop the highest peak in the western hemisphere.
THE PENNANT was placed on the summit of Mount Aconcagua in western Argentina by Dr. Gene Mason of Lake Stevens, Wash.
Dr. Mason, 36, and two companions, Dr. Richard Hill, 34, of Bellevue, Wash., and Ralph Mackey, 34, of Everett, reached the summit of the mountain, more than 23,000 feet above sea level, on Jan. 17.
One of Dr. Mason's first acts there was to unfurl the pennant he had carried on the difficult climb.
"The Sisters at Providence Hospital in Everett asked if I would take a pennant with me from them and I was happy to oblige," Dr. Mason said.
Dr. Mason, himself not a Catholic, is chief of the anesthesia department at the hospital. The Sisters of Providence maintain several hospitals in Argentina.
The success of the Washington state party in being the first to scale the difficult north slope of the mountain was dimmed by the death of Father Fernando de la Mora, 43, a Mexican priest.
The priest and a young German companion, their strength sapped by a blinding snowstorm, died on the mountain (Jan. 15) with shelter just 500 feet away.
