

Door Opened For Talks with Atheists, Reds

Vatican City (RNS) — Pope Paul VI has established a Vatican Secretariat for Non-Believers and named Franz Cardinal Koenig, Archbishop of Vienna, as its president, Vatican Authorities announced.

According to a spokesman of the Holy See, the term "non-believer" would be understood to embrace atheists, Communists, skeptics and agnostics.

The Pope's action had been preceded by reports in March that he was planning to initiate some form of program for a continuing dialogue with those professing atheism.

The Vatican announcement also confirmed that the Pope had also named a secretary for the new secretariat — Father Vincenzo Miano, dean of the faculty of philosophy at the Pontifical Salesian University in Rome.

Father Miano, it was disclosed, is at present preparing a massive encyclopedia which will be translated into many languages for worldwide distribution.

The new secretariat is the third such group formed since the late Pope John XXIII announced creation of the Vatican Secretariat for Promoting Christian Unity shortly after he had summoned the Second Vatican Council. In May, 1964, Pope Paul revealed plans to establish the Secretariat for Non-Christians, as had been suggested a year before by Bishop Antoine Thijssen, S.V.D., of Lanjutka, Indonesia.

Pope Paul had indicated the creation of the new Vatican body in his first encyclical letter, Ecclesiam Suam, in which he clearly intimated the possibility of a dialogue with professed atheists, saying:

"We do not despair that they may one day be able to enter into a more positive dialogue with the Church than the present one which we now of necessity deplore and lament."

The pontiff went on to say that "sometimes the atheist is spurred on by noble sentiments and by impatience with the mediocrity and self-seeking of so many contemporary social settings. He knows well how to borrow from our Gospels modes and expressions of solidarity and human compassion. Shall we not be able to lead him back

Pope Repeats Unity Plea

Vatican City (RNS) — Pope Paul VI, for the second time in less than a week, spoke out strongly in favor of European unity as of "great importance" to the world.

This was at an audience to a working group of the Consultative Assembly of the Council of Europe. It followed a previous audience to members of the general assembly of the Economic and Social Committee of the European Economic Community.

"The Church," the Pope said, "has no competence in deciding which are the best political solutions to adopt in order to attain the pursued objectives. But it is these same objectives which interest her and which we find very happily formulated among the recent recommendations of your Consultative Assembly — the attainment of European unity which would be the closest possible in that which concerns the ties between the nations of Europe and in that which concerns its frontiers."

here, creation of a special commission within the Roman Curia to study contemporary atheism had been urged by a prelate from Communist Yugoslavia at the Vatican Council's 39th general congregation in October, 1963.

The suggestion came from Bishop Franjo Franjo-Split, who told the Council Fathers that the commission would serve as a clearing house to help bishops throughout the world in combating atheism.

More recently, Coadjutor Archbishop Pierre Vuilliot of Paris (a journalist's son who

formerly spent 10 years in the French section of the Vatican Secretariat of State) strongly endorsed a "meeting of minds" between Christians and non-believers.

This was suggested at the 17th Catholic Intellectual Week in Paris early in March which was marked by a frank discussion of Christianity and atheism.

IN SELECTING Cardinal Koenig to head the new secretariat, Pope Paul chose a prelate who once declared that "we have nothing against the peoples living under materialist re-
