Children's Theatre

Auditions Draw 500 Youngsters

Auditions were held on April 9 and 10 at Our Lady of Lourdes School for parts in "Tom Sawyer" a musical comedy to be presented in July by the Children's Summer Theatre under the direction of the Sisters of St. Joseph.

Sister Claudia, in charge of this summer program, had hoped for at least 150 or 200 boys and girls from which to select the cast, which— including singers, dancers, and orchestra members—will number about 100. Instead over 500 young people between the ages of 10 and 16 filled the audition rooms to overflowing and necessitated a second casting session on April 17 of the forty-four who were finally chosen to try out for the principal parts.

between listening to would-be "Toms" and "Hacks" and "Aunt Polly." Sister Claudia commented on this surprisingly large number of Rochester boys and girls who showed such enthusiasm and interest in the theater.

Actually, Sister said, since the end of the Clare Tree Major Players, Rochester has offered its young people no specific "Children's Theatre"—a professional term which is meant to high school age—although Community Players and other adult groups do have occasional plays for children.

Sister Claudia believes that there is a real need for such include boys and girls through theater in order to educate young people to the stage and give them an appreciation of good theater.

If their plays are wisely selected, suitable to the situations and emotions which they are able to grasp, such theater gives them an activity in which they can participate, create and learn—working hard, submitting to rigorous disciplines, and yet enjoying themselves.

**Census Teams
Total 15,000**

Recruitment of more than 15,000 parishioners to conduct a diocesan wide census was under way in the 156 parishes and 29 missions of the Rochester Diocese.

Census programs will begin in 91 parishes Sunday afternoon, May 23. These include parishes in Monroe County, Auburn, Elmira, Elmira Heights and Horseheads.

Census visits in the remaining 65 parishes are slated to be made on a staggered schedule from May 3 through June 9.

A "pilot" census project was begun this week in portions of downtown Rochester. Participating as enumerators were nearly 80 students of St. Bernard's and St. Andrew's Seminaries who volunteered a portion of their Easter vacation for the cause.

Purpose of the census, first of its kind for the Diocese, is to obtain general information about the religious practices of all baptized Catholics.
