## Children of Diocese

# Rate High In Mission Support

Mission-minded children in the Diocese of Rochester are among the leaders in the United States in supporting the Holy Childhood Association program, according to the 1964 report from that group.

Eighth place among the one hundred sixteen dioceses of the United States is held by the Diocese of Rochester in the report for 1964, according to figures released by the National Office of the Episcopal Association of the Holy Childhood.

"Although the figure of \$55,553.00 was only about five hundred dollars above the total for 1963, it was still enough to assure us of this fine position

in the country," the Rev. John F. Duffy, Diocesan Director announced this week. "In fact," Father Duffy continued, "when we figure in the twenty-eight archdioceses we are happy to see that we occupy a position of sixteen among one hundred forty-four in the country."

Two parochial schools in the Diocese of Rochester passed the two thousand dollar figure in the Mission Program of "children helping children." The Cathedral Parish School realized \$2,636.00 and was followed by St. Andrew's School of Rochester with the sum of \$2,228.00.

The leading school outside the Rochester metropolitan area was St. Mary's School in Can-

andaigua with the sum of \$1,035.00. Top school for the Auburn area with a figure of \$920 was Holy Family, and for the Southern Tier, St. Mary's School of Elmira was the leader with \$826.00.

In the work of Adoptions of Pagan Babies, the leading St. Andrew's School of Rochester with its \$1,070.00 was followed closely by Holy Family School of Rochester with a final mark of \$1,015.00.

"We in the Rochester Diocese may be tempted to feel our \$55,000 is somewhat dwarfed by the \$256,000 given by the country's leaders, the Archdiocese of Los Angeles," Father Duffy observed, "but at the

same time it is interesting to read the rest of the National Report."

Looking over the report, the Rochester Diocesan Director of the Holy Childhood emphasized the fact that "eighteen parish schools of our diocese went over the thousand dollar mark, while eight dioceses in the United States did not reach a \$1,000 for a whole diocese. And Sacred Heart Cathedral School and Saint Andrew's School in Rochester each contributed more than any one of twenty different dioceses in the United States."
