

Priest, Critic of Church, Reinstated in Parish

London — (RNS) — Father Joseph Cocker, a 26-year-old Roman Catholic priest who was suspended in February for speaking against the Church's teaching on birth control, has been reinstated and given a new post.

The young priest was serving as a curate on the Isle of Wight when he was suspended for defending the views of another priest, Father Arnold McMahon, who had been summoned to Rome after publicly advocating contraception for Roman Catholics. Father Cocker has been given a new post as assistant priest at East Heston, in Berkshire County, west of London.

Father Cocker was said to have made clear to friends in letters that he would not change his views. However, in reporting on his new post, Mr. Sidney J. Mullarkey, vicar general of Portsmouth, who was placed in charge of Father Cocker's case in March, said "I am satisfied that Father Cocker is anxious to work as a good priest in obedience to his superiors, as long as his actions bear out what he has said he wishes to do he will remain in office. I am confident that he will act as any other priest would in this matter."

Mrs. Mullarkey, who said Father Cocker's new post was temporary, also commented that relations between them were "quite amicable."

Father Cocker is under attack from another quarter on a different subject. In the issue of Search, an independent Catholic newsletter, Dom Milroy of Ampleforth Abbey accuses him of indulging in "facile and destructive sneers."

Dom Milroy's comments followed Search's publication in March of an article by Father Cocker who criticized such "dying" devotions as the Rosaries and Litanies. Father Cocker likened the Rosary to a "monotonous and boring relic of past ages," and litanies had "intolerable whiny prayers and gushing terms of endearment."

Probe Catholic Unity

Addis Ababa — (NC) — The major Eastern churches which withdrew from communion with both the See of Rome and Constantinople after the Council of Chalcedon, 15 centuries ago have agreed on exploratory conversations with the Roman Catholic Church.

At the same time they also decided to pursue and solidify their relations with the World Council of Churches. And they decided to set up a joint commission to promote renewal within their own communions.

The churches involved issued their final report at the conclusion of a week-long meeting here which was the first such "summit" session. The meeting was convened by Emperor Haile Selassie of Ethiopia, who is honorary head of the Coptic Church in Ethiopia.

While the gathering of the non-Byzantine Eastern Christian church leaders was to have been immediately followed by a more general meeting with representatives of the Orthodox Churches in communion with the Patriarch of Constantinople, that meeting was postponed.

The non-Byzantine churchmen named a commission, with two representatives from each church, to set up a permanent body to be entrusted with the work of internal reform. Among the proposed changes to be studied by the permanent commission are rules concerning fasting and abstinence, renewal of the monastic spirit, adoption of the Gregorian calendar, and

drawing young people more fully into the life of the churches.

Emperor Haile Selassie, in his opening address to the meeting, had stressed that in this era in which the world as a whole is seeking unity, the Christian churches of the East should be able to set the example. He asked the church leaders to pursue the road to unity — "leaving their differences aside, to tackle common problems, and find ways and means for the achievements and preservation of world peace. The Church should not overlook this great task because she is the origin of peace and brotherhood."

A procession including 40 children from the kindergarten and first grades opened the ceremonies.

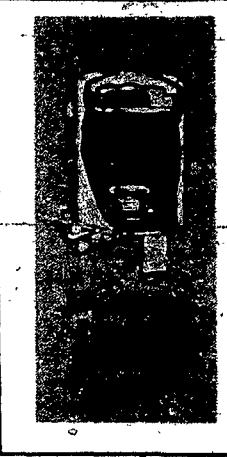
William C. Loree was organist. Leading the procession were Kimberly Curran and Mary Kay Dodd.
