**Parish Leaders Being Chosen**

Selection of parish committee chairmen and secretaries for the parish phase of the \$9 million Joint College Fund campaign was under way this week. Briefing meetings for parish committee chairmen, secretaries and members are scheduled this month in three diocesan regions. The briefing meetings are slated as follows:

**Tuesday, Aug. 17, Rochester**—Region I, comprising parishes in Monroe and Livingston Counties and in western Ontario County.

**Wednesday, Aug. 18, Auburn**—Region II, comprising parishes in Cayuga, Wayne, Seneca and Yates Counties and in eastern Ontario County.

**Tuesday, Aug. 24, Elmira**—Region III, comprising parishes in Chemung, Tioga, Tompkins, Schuyler and Steuben Counties.

Aims of the drive, which will climax in autumn, is the expansion of building facilities at St. John Fisher and Nazareth Colleges and the construction of a diocesan house of studies adjacent to the St. John Fisher campus for students who intend to pursue theological studies following their college courses.

Robert B. Wegman, a member of St. Thomas More Church, Rochester, is chairman of the general campaign committee. Paul A. McGuire, of Our Lady of Lourdes Church, Rochester,

is vice chairman in charge of the parish solicitation division. Committees now being formed include corporations, commerce and industry, major gifts, alumni and alumnae, special gifts and parish solicitation. Instruction meetings for parish committees are slated from Oct. 4 through Oct. 20. Solicitation of contributions from parishioners of the 156 parishes and 29 missions of the 12-county Diocese will be conducted on Oct. 31 and Nov. 14.

**Special Mass For St. Benedict**

Vatican City — (RNS)—The Sacred Congregation of Rites has approved a special Mass for St. Benedict, who was proclaimed Patron and Protector of Europe by Pope Paul VI last October.

The Mass, it was announced, may be said in all Catholic churches in Europe on July 11. The saint's universal feast day falls on March 21.

St. Benedict, variously called "the Father of Western Europe," "the Patriarch of Labor," and "the Father of Peace," was born in the District of Norcia in Umbria, central Italy, around 480. He is traditionally venerated as the Father of Western monasticism. He founded the famous Abbey of Monte Cassino in 529 and lived there until his death around 550.

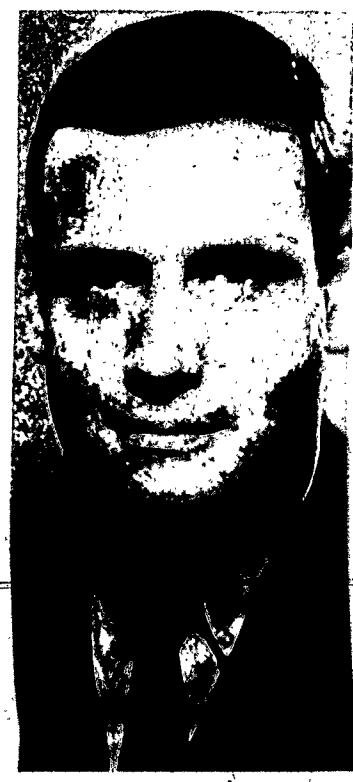

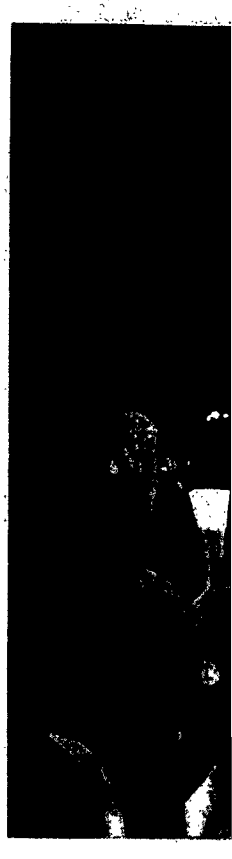
