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Parish, Diocese On Way Out

Melbourne — (NC) — There is strong sentiment in the Vatican council in favor of dropping the words "parish" and "diocese," Archbishop Justin D. Simmonds of Melbourne said.

Speaking at the opening of additions to a school in a Melbourne suburb, the archbishop said, "The word 'diocese' belongs to an early period of the Roman empire. It is a civil term and not an ecclesiastical term at all."

The early Fathers of the Church spoke of the Church of Antioch and so on — the whole Church emphasizing the friendship and fellowship of one Church with another. We are trying to get back to that term 'Church,' he said.
