**\$5.7 Million Goal for Parishes**

A total of \$5,750,000 in cash and pledges will be sought in the parish phase of the \$9 million Joint College Fund drive, it was announced this week.

This will be the minimum goal for parishes of the 156 parishes and 29 missions of the 12-county Diocese.

Solicitation of parishioners is scheduled on two Sunday afternoons, Oct. 31 and Nov. 14.

Organization of a committee of 15,000 volunteers to call on parishioners is now under way. Chairman of the parish phase is Paul A. McGuire, Rochester.

Details of campaign procedure were outlined at dinner meetings in Rochester and Auburn this week. A similar meet-

ing is slated at 7 p.m. Tuesday, Aug. 24, in the Mark Twain Hotel, Elmira.

Bishop Kearney was principal speaker at the Rochester area meeting, held at Nazareth College on Tuesday. He stressed the continuing need for religious education and praised the record of the diocesan seminars and of St. John Fisher and Nazareth Colleges.

Part of the parishioner contributions will be allocated for construction of the Diocesan House of Studies adjacent to the St. John Fisher campus. The remainder will go toward the needs of the two colleges for expansion of buildings.

Besides the parish phase of the drive, committees are being organized to seek contributions from corporations, business and industry, selected individuals and alumni and alumnae.
