Fr. Peter Lis Rites Held In Buffalo

Rev. Peter Lis, O.F.M. Conv., former assistant pastor of St. Theresa Church in Rochester, N.Y. died Wednesday morning, August 25, 1965 in Lehigh Clinic in Boston, Mass. after a short illness.

He was born in Buffalo, N.Y., son of the late Alfred and Mary

(Kupiec) Lis. He received his early education in the parochial schools in Buffalo.

Father Lis entered the Franciscan Novitiate in St. Joseph Cupertino, Ellicott City, Md., studied philosophy at St. Hyacinth's Seminary, Granby, Mass., and was sent to Rome for his theological studies, but later returned due to the outbreak of the war.

Father Lis was ordained July 5, 1941 in St. Stanislaus Church, Chicopee, Mass. by the Bishop Thomas M. O'Leary of Springfield Diocese.

He was stationed at St. Anthony's Church in Willimansett, Mass. for a short time then sent to St. Theresa's Church in Rochester, N.Y. where he was active in church and social work until the year 1960 when he was assigned to the Queen of the Most Holy Rosary Church in Buffalo, N.Y. His last assignment was in St. Stanislaus Church in Chicopee, from 1963 to the time of his death.

He leaves two brothers, Anthony and John, both of Buffalo, and two sisters, Mrs. Helen Panfil and Mrs. Julia Sterneckl.
