Spanish Speaking Retreat Scheduled at Notre Dame

Recently seventeen men and women met at Notre Dame Retreat House to plan a weekend of spiritual exercises for Spanish speaking people in the diocese. A Spanish retreat weekend will be held Nov. 26, 27 and 28.

"Because of a language barrier," said Father Moran, director of retreats, "these people very often miss out on the Word of God. But this retreat will be given totally in Spanish and will be open to both men and women."

The content and format of the retreat will follow the traditional lines. As with all the retreats now given at Notre Dame, more emphasis will be given to living Christianity together for a weekend rather than just studying Christianity for a weekend. "The spirit of such retreats," said Fr. Moran, "is much like the spirit of the early Christians as found in the Acts of the Apostles."
