

Catholics Gain In Japan

Tokyo—(NC)—Catholics in Japan now number 323,880 in a total population of 97,259,790, an increase of 8,508 during the past year, according to statistics issued by the Japanese National Catholic Committee.

The committee said there were 8,029 adult baptisms between July 1, 1964, and June 30, 1965. There were 15,061 catechumens on June 30, 1965, an increase of about 700 over the previous year.

Lima Girl In Peace Corps

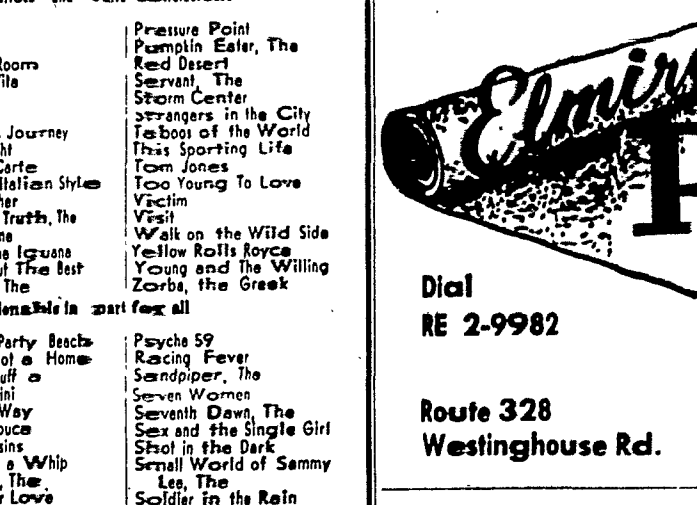
