Group Promotes Chardin Study

London — (NC) — An office has been established here to give wider circulation to the ideas of the French Jesuit paleontologist, Father Pierre Teilhard de Chardin who died in 1955.

The Teilhard de Chardin Association of Great Britain and Ireland was formally constituted at a meeting of 340 Teilhard devotees here to "interpret Teilhard's ideas for the man in the street, so that they might be carried into the political, social, scientific and religious life of the country," said Father Thomas Corbishley, S.J.

Father Corbishley said Father Teilhard's greatest achievement was to point up the fact that "the universe is Christocentric."

Vatican City — (NC) — The "Little Singers" of the Cathedral of Ratisbon, Germany, members of the Catholic Academy of Bavaria and the leaders of Austria's Catholic Action organization were received in audience here by Pope Paul VI.

CCD Exhibit In Rome on New Methods

Rome — (NC) — A display of new methods and literature used in the international work of the Confraternity of Christian Doctrine was officially opened here under the auspices of the Congregation of the Council.

With the special direction of the congregation's prefect, Pietro Cardinal Ciriaci, the display — including charts and historical sketches, textbooks and brochures — was set up in the lobby of the Vatican Council press office near St. Peter's Square for the benefit of bishops, priests and laity attending the Council and the world's press who congregate there daily.

It was opened Oct. 20 following an informal reception of sponsoring bishops from the U.S. and Canada the evening before.

Throughout the remainder of the Council, seminarians and student priests from Rome's North American College, with Father Ramon Garcia, CCD representative from the U.S. in Latin America, will be on hand to explain special features of the exhibit and of the renewal underway in catechetical methods. CCD literature is available in Spanish, Portuguese, and English.

Tablet Editor

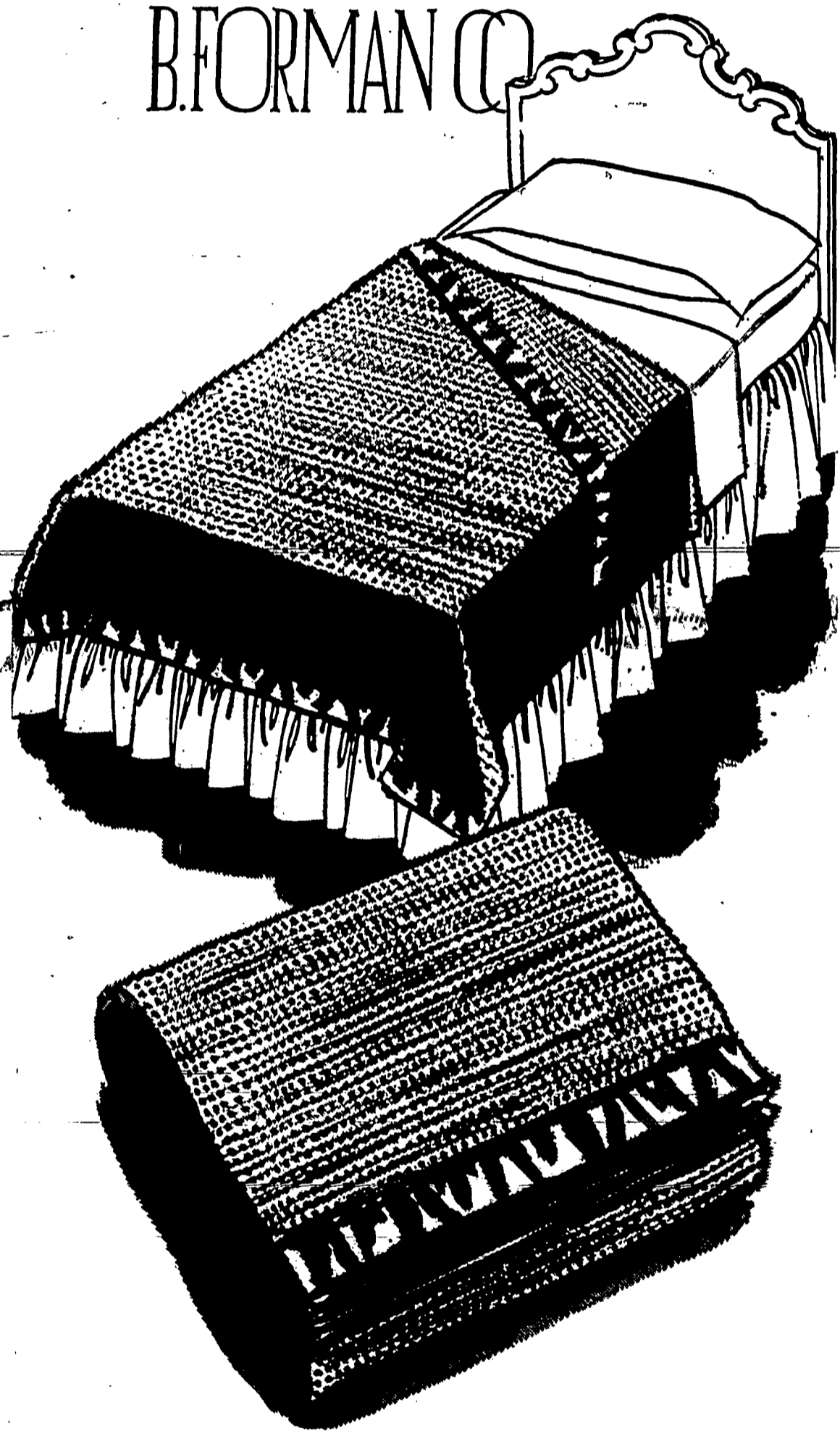

New Orleans — (RNS) — Auxiliary Bishop-elect Harold R. Perry of New Orleans, first American-born Negro Catholic bishop in the South, passes a picket protesting his appointment to the Louisiana See. Woman holding sign is Mrs. J. B. Gallot, who was excommunicated in 1962 for defiant opposition to the Catholic stand on desegregation. She was among a group of segregationists who picketed the installation of Most Rev. Philip M. Hannan as 11th Archbishop of New Orleans. Although New Orleans segregationists expressed outrage at the appointment of Bishop Perry, he was lauded by many Non-Catholic clergymen and Negro leaders in the city.

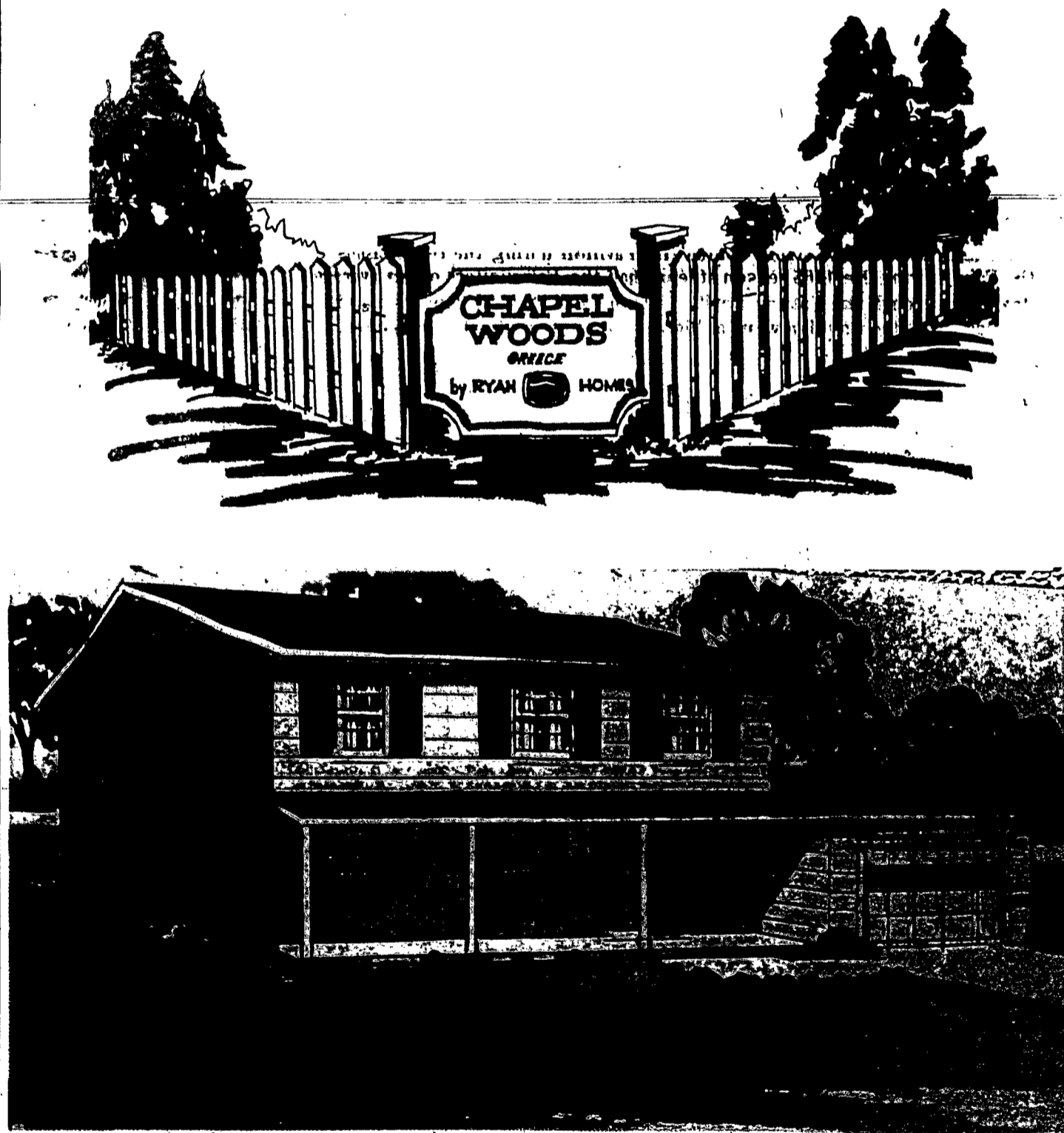

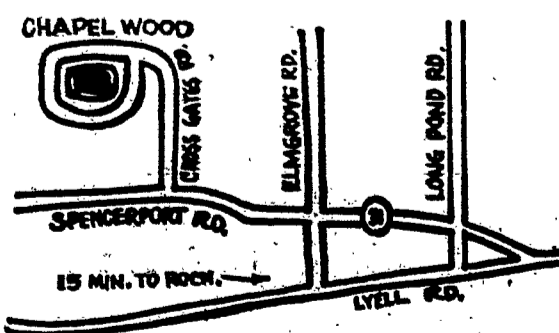
