Modern Ireland Report on Channel 10 A two-part film report on modern Ireland will be seen on "Look Up and Live" Sunday, Nov. 7, and 14 (10:30-11:00 a.m., EST, Channel 10 in the Rochester Area). Prime Minister Sean Lemass answers questions on socio-economic progress in Ireland since World War II. William Cardinal Conway, leading Catholic prelate in Ireland, gives his views of the role of the Church in modern Ireland. Others interviewed include Senator Garrett Fitzgerald, labor leader James Dunne, biologist Patricia Boyle, author James Plunkett, review editor Rev. James McGarry, farmer James Lawlor, and Patricia Pye. Film sequences give a vivid picture of life in Ireland today. "Like most of the other newly freed small countries of the world," Lemass says on the program, "we started off with a somewhat general idea that freedom itself would be enough and that in freedom all the economic decay and social distress, which external rule had brought, would more or less disappear of its own accord. But we found out that freedom was just an opportunity for dealing with these matters provided we organized ourselves." Cardinal Conway sees "a new society... coming in Ireland... with the coming of a certain degree of affluence; and undoubtedly it will be necessary to have a social philosophy with clearly marked objectives in that new society. I think, therefore, that there's need for a great deal of hard thinking and hard work in applying the principles of the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the new society which will exist in Ireland."
