U.S. Pastor Has Last Word

Vatican City — (RNS) — An American pastor has had the last word in the four years of regular debate at the Second Vatican Council—barring some unforeseen modification requiring debate before the Council finally adjourns.

Elevated to the rank of domestic prelate that same morning, the priest was Mgr. Thomas B. Falls, pastor of the Sacred Heart Parish of Manoa in suburban Philadelphia. One of the ten priest-auditors invited to the Council as silent participants, he was chosen to speak in the name of all pastors and diocesan priests when debate closed on the schema on the Priestly Life and Ministry.

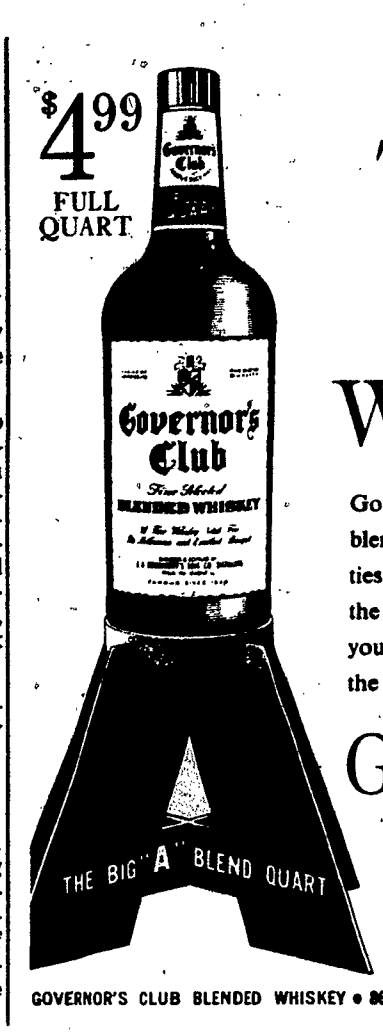
Poet Roy L. Hill To Speak at Nazareth

Roy L. Hill, Negro poet, short story writer, journalist and teacher, will visit the Nazareth College campus Wednesday and Thursday, Nov. 10 and 11, concluding with a lecture open to the public at 3:30 p.m. Thursday in the college auditorium.

The lecture will be "Poets of Passion and Protest," highlighting the work of Leslie Pinckney Hill, Langston Hughes, Le Roi Jones, Countee Cullen and others.

Hill, presently Poet-in-Residence at Chadron State College in Nebraska, has also taught at Penn State, South Carolina State College, University of Denver, and, last year, at the State University College at Fredonia.

His poem "Sad People" received national attention and publication in 1957, and a complete volume of poetry "Corrie J. Carroll and Other Poems," was published in 1962.
