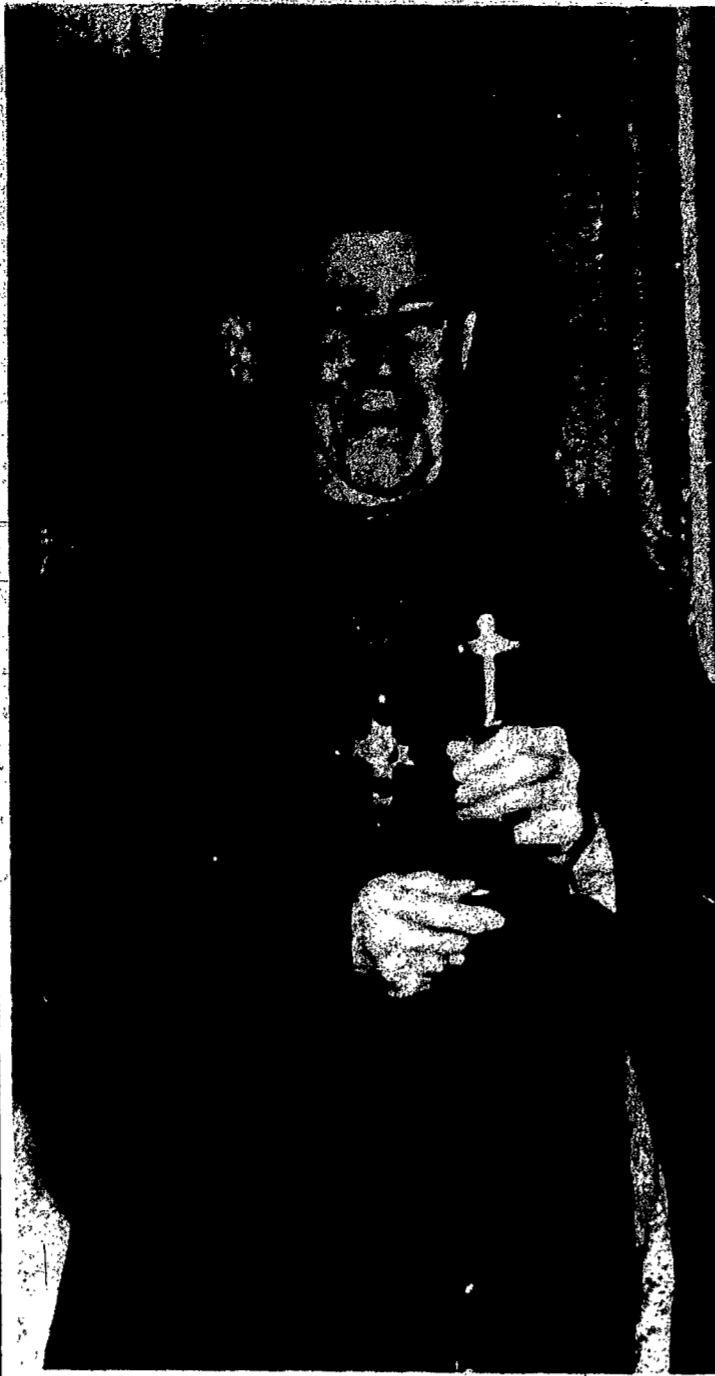




Lieutenant Governor Malcolm Wilson gave a birthday tribute to Bishop Kearney.

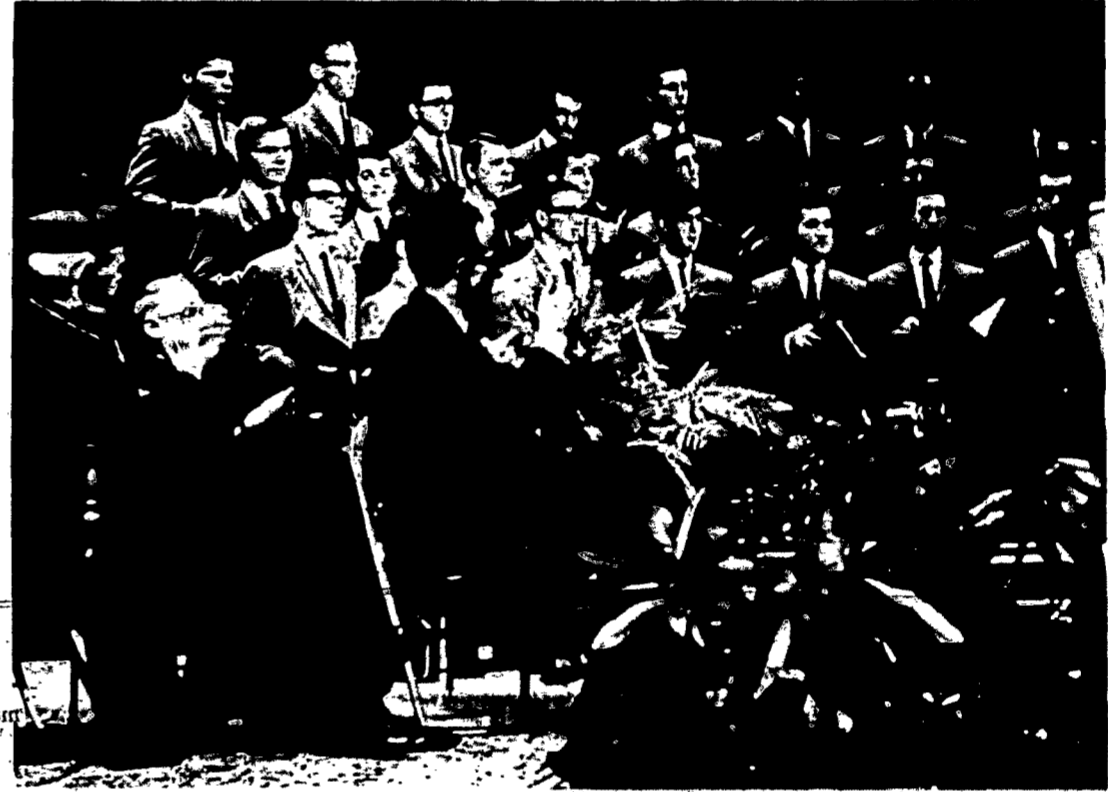

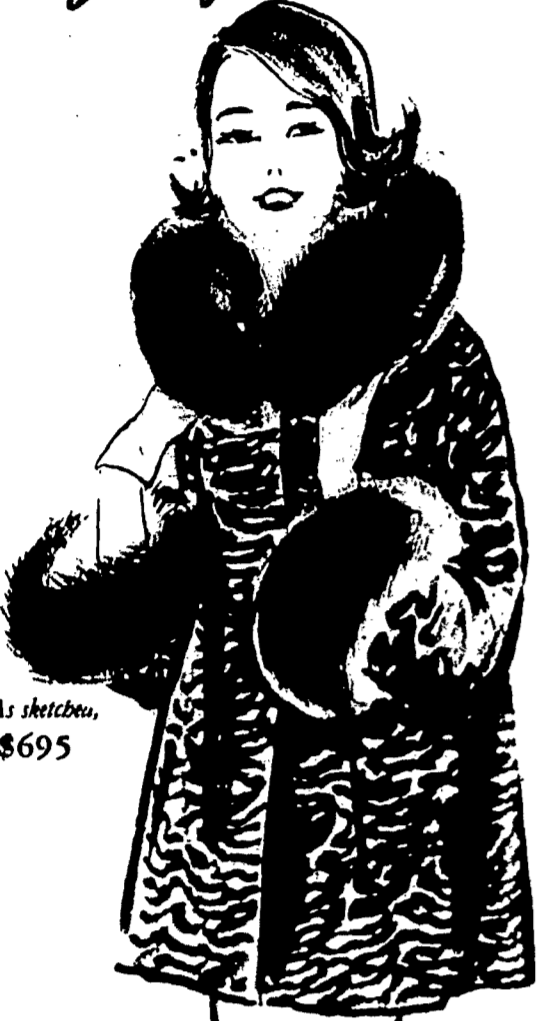
