Civil Rights Talk at Fisher

Dr. Morsell will give a public lecture to be given by Dr. John A. Morsell, assistant executive director, National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, at St. John Fisher College, Tuesday, Nov. 23, at 8:15 p.m. in St. Basil Hall auditorium.

A member of the NAACP staff since 1956, Dr. Morsell has been involved in studies of racial problems for many years. For five years he served as a study director with International Research Associates, Inc., on projects involving assignments in the Far East, Europe, and Latin America.

He also has worked for the Bureau of Applied Social Research, Columbia University; the Institute of Community Relations, Sydenham Hospital; the New York City Department of Welfare; the Mayor's Commission on Conditions in Harlem; and as a member of a field staff studying effects of racial integration in the U.S. Army.

Dr. Morsell was a cum laude graduate of City College of New York and was elected to Phi Beta Kappa, Columbia University granted him the master of arts in social legislation in 1938 and a Ph.D. in sociology in 1951. He has been a frequent contributor of articles to professional journals and magazines.
