Jesuit Differs With Superior

Nijmegen — (NC) — The Dutch provincial of the Society of Jesus confessed that he disagrees with recent utterances of the Spanish-born Jesuit general, Father Pedro Arrupe, S.J., on the subject of atheism and Church criticism.

Speaking to the alumni association of St. Peter Canisius College Father Jan Terpstra, S.J., said Father Arrupe's theology is dated by Dutch standards and that his mode of expression is the kind to create confusion in northern European countries.

Father Terpstra referred in his talk to Dutch criticisms of Father Arrupe's speech on atheism at the Vatican Council and to a subsequent interview of the Jesuit general in a Spanish magazine dealing with critics of the Church.
