New York — Douglas A. Larie of Syracuse, N.Y., has been appointed to the position of assistant director of Catholic Relief Services (CRS) aid.

During fiscal year 1965, CRS conducted a mass feeding program in Algeria that benefited 550,000 needy persons, including 300,000 children fed through a nationwide school lunch program.

Larie served previously with Catholic Relief Services in Africa from June, 1961 until November, 1963. Prior to joining the overseas staff of CRS, he was working with the Crusade for Opportunity in Syracuse and Onondaga County.
