An 'Escape' Into the Whole World

In France, in the diocese of Lyon, the Abbe Paul Couturier realized that Christians who were not Catholics, despite their desire for religious unity, could not with sincerity pray for their own "conversion."

Father Couturier wrote in 1935, "Neither Catholic prayer, nor Orthodox prayer, nor Anglican prayer, nor Protestant prayer suffice. All of them are necessary, and all of them together."

He listed as daily intentions, prayers simply for Christians of the various churches, for Jews, for Moslems, etc.

Catholics continued then, as they still do, to believe that complete unity cannot be attained apart from the pope, the successor of Peter, but Father Couturier set as the goals of his octave not so much the conversion of others but rather the spiritual growth of the participants themselves so they may be "worthy of the unity that Christ wants His Church to have."

Both Catholics and Protestants accepted his proposal enthusiastically and in this new format the devotion spread in Europe—although the prayers were said separately: Catholics in their own churches and Protestants in theirs.

The Vatican Council authorized Catholics to join Protestants and other Christians in prayers for unity and, four days before the Council closed, Pope Paul set the example for such action by participating in a unity-rite at the Church of St. Paul near Rome, where Pope John in 1959 first announced his intention to hold "a Council for unity."

The majestic church marks the spot of St. Paul's martyrdom and thus served not only as an historic link with the days of Christianity before the Church was fragmented but also as a delicate courtesy to the Protestants who attended the rite for St. Paul is traditionally deeply revered by them.

So the story comes full circle next Tuesday when Christians recall the conversion and escape of St. Paul and their own "escape" from a separatism and isolation to a wider world of prayer and work together to attain the desire of their Lord "that they all may be one."
