

No Major Changes in Mass For Several Years Yet

For Catholics who are a bit breathless trying to keep up with the liturgical changes, came a reassuring word from the head of the Diocesan Liturgy Commission last week.

"We don't anticipate any major changes in the Mass for several years," stated Monsignor Wilfred T. Craugh, chairman of the commission. Monsignor Craugh is rector of St. Bernard's Seminary in Rochester.

The Diocese of Rochester is actually a few months ahead of the rest of the country in its recent (Advent, 1965) move to use English in the Mass orations and prefaces, he pointed out.

Eventually, there will be a completely revised Missal proposed by the post-Conciliar Council, set up to implement Vatican II Council's decree on Sacred Liturgy. It will probably contain a much greater variety of Scripture readings, possibly

when the tabernacle is located behind a priest facing the people, it should be placed high enough, so that it is not hidden behind the celebrant.

In new churches to be built in the Diocese, the main altar must be built facing the people. In older churches, the forward facing altar may be installed in keeping with the "Guidelines" prescriptions.

"There is no order to turn the altars around," noted Monsignor Craugh, and added that there are some churches in which it would be impossible to install an altar facing the people because of the small size of the sanctuaries.

running through a cycle of three years, instead of one year as at present. But this large-scale revamping is still several years off.

Monsignor Craugh expressed satisfaction at the Liturgy "aggiornamento" as it has taken place in the Diocese of Rochester to this point.

"The pastoral efforts and the cooperation of the people are to be commended, he said.

Current focus of the local commission's activity is on guidelines for the redecoration of sanctuaries. They have just sent out a memo to all pastors with principles and specifics to be followed when renovating church sanctuaries.

"We are passing on the best ways of carrying out the spirit of the decree on the liturgy," explained the seminary rector.

Location of the tabernacle poses some problems, and the memo to pastors reminds them that the Instruction of Sept 26, 1965 from Rome lists three possible locations for the tabernacle:

1. In the center of the main altar. If the altar faces the people, a "low but suitable" tabernacle may be used.
2. On a minor (side) "but truly outstanding" altar.
3. With the consent of the Bishop, in some other "noble and properly adorned" part of the Church.

The "Guidelines" pointed out

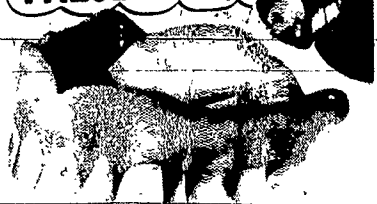
Holiday Monday For Pupils, but Not at Aquinas
