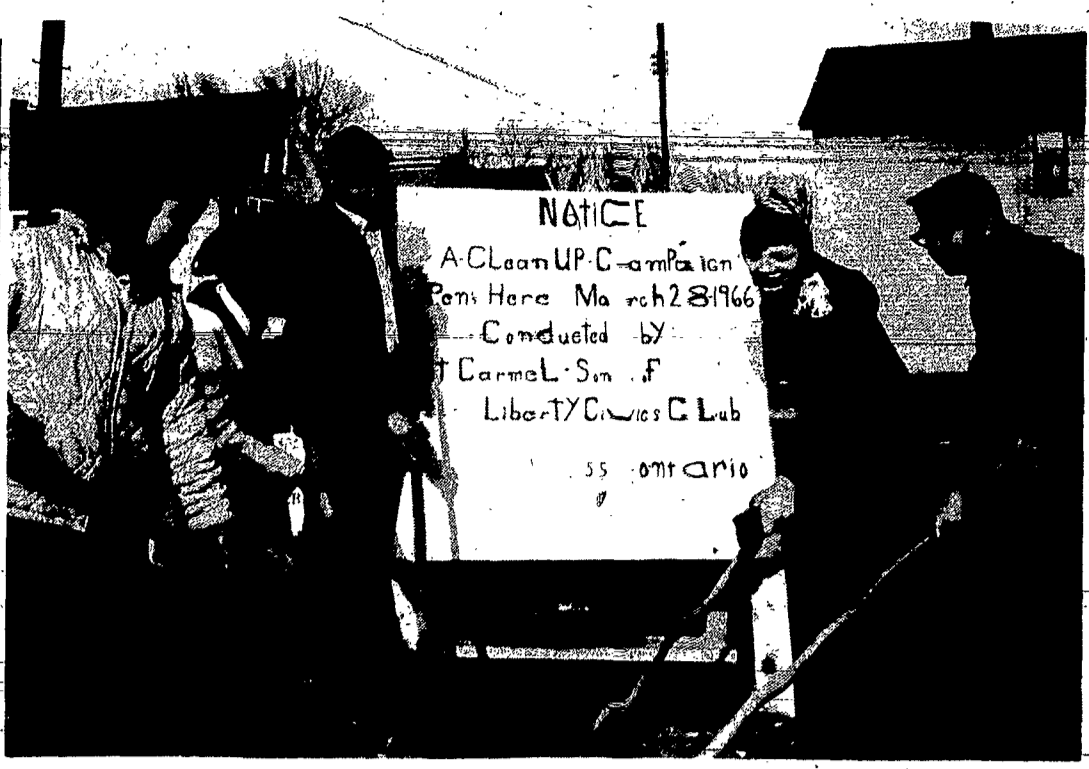

Rabbi Solomon Speaks At Hornell Breakfast

Rabbi Solomon traced the course of brotherhood from the Old Testament to the actions of the late Pope John.

"We have seen the dawn of a new day," he said. "Pope John had a tremendous vision, a prophetic vision to build a new world, a better world for man regardless of race, creed or color."

"He convened an Ecumenical Council and the world became aware of a new world, it became aware of ecumenism. The world was weary of hate, war and antagonism and welcomed the blessed effort towards peace."
