**McQuaid Jesuit Lists Original Musical Play**

McQuaid Jesuit High School is now preparing a revised version of an original play about knights and dragons for presentation on April 1 and 2 at Strong Memorial Auditorium on the University of Rochester campus. The play, "Tender is the Knight," was written by Father William O'Malley, S. J. It is a musical satire, attacking the use of tradition for the simple reason that it is tradition. In the lead role of Gawaine le Coeur Hardy is Paul Camardo of McQuaid. Mary John Boylan of Mercy High is playing the lead female role, that of a dragonette named Dagnar. Other lead roles are Jeremy Abbot as Malvoada, a witch; Frank Cecilia as Sir Carnivore, headmaster of the knights' School; James Logar as Merlin; Martin Duffy as Sir Columbusby; and John Pelkey as Sir Flutterius. Lyrics were written by Father O'Malley. The play was originally presented at Woodstock Jesuit Seminary in New York City and was revised to bring it up to date. Pianists for the production are Bill Cawley and Ron Catese. Assistant directors are Thomas Terpey and John Butler. Girls from both Mercy High and St. Agnes High are taking parts in the girls' chorus. All boys' parts will be played by McQuaid students.
