**Requiem Sung**

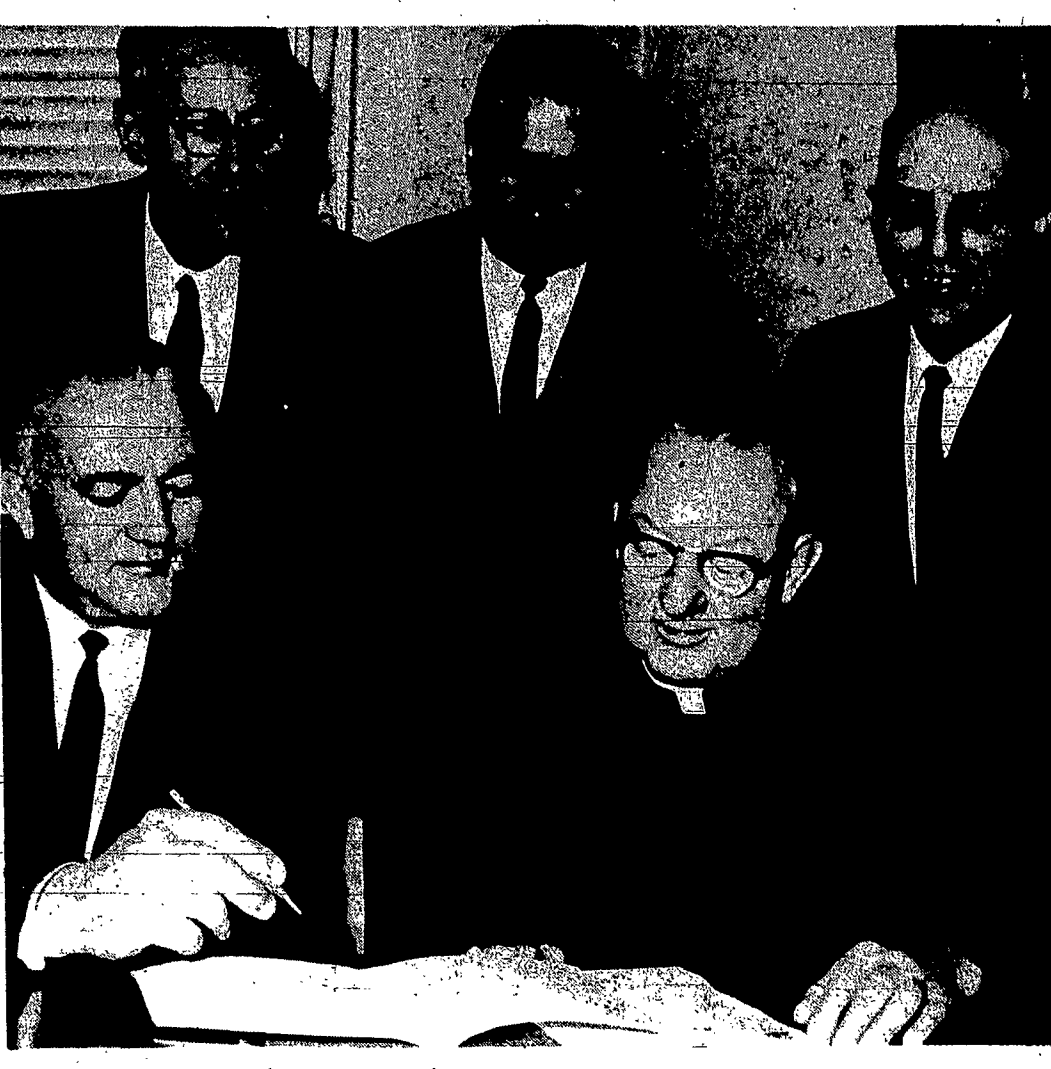
