Prelate Bids Adieu for Rome

Toulouse — (RNS) — Archbishop Gabriel Garrone of Toulouse took solemn leave of his clergy and laity prior to leaving for Rome to assume his new post — of Pro-Prefect of the Sacred Congregation for Seminaries and Universities.

The ceremony took place in the Cathedral of St. Stephen, where the archbishop concelebrated Mass with his Vicars General and other priests. Among the thousands of faithful present were many civil officials.

Archbishop Garrone was named to the Curia post by Pope Paul VI last February to lighten the work of Giuseppe Cardinal Pizzardo, prefect of the Roman Catholic Congregation, who will be 89 in July.

Archbishop Garrone, who is 65, was named to the Toulouse See in 1955 after long and outstanding service as educator and seminary rector. He was a member of the Vatican II's Theological Commission and helped draft the decree on the Church in the Modern World.
