Why, this was an announcement of the Second Annual Worry Clinic. After having so thoroughly enjoyed the session last year, we wouldn't miss this for anything!

Now this was an invitation! Promptly at 9:45 on that particular morning we joined several hundred other female worriers of all sizes, shapes and ages, all prepared to worry away openly and unabashedly for 4 hours, even through the luncheon period.

Take Your Choice. To give everybody a fair chance, we were allowed to pick our own coterie of fellow fretters, divide ourselves into classes, the way they do with race horses.

Having worried our way for years through the first four groupings, Master Class was obviously our dish of tea. We were strangers, each with a problem. The very anonymity provided a therapeutic atmosphere; each participant gave a brief statement of what was troubling her.

During the last hour of the session, all groups met together or a resumé of highlighted worries, babies screaming when left with a sitter, toy wars, thumb sucking, underachieving in school, sibling rivalry, foreing vs. dropping of piano lessons, teenage fads and foolishness, darning, use of the car, "sheepskin psychosis" producing almost unbearable tensions for youngsters unequipped to enter or remain in college.

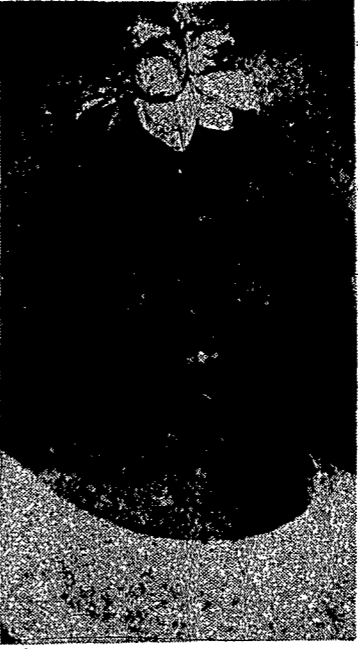
Miss Mary D'Ortona was her sister's maid of honor. William Sharpe was his brother's best man.
