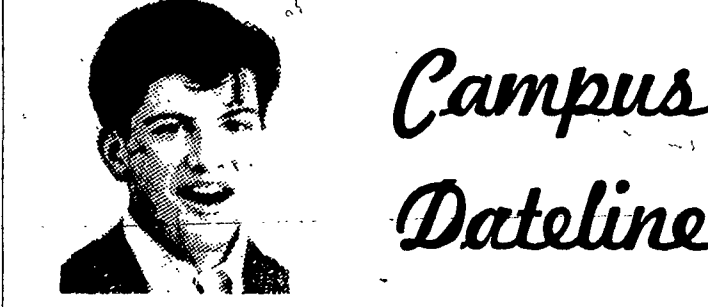


SPEED READING. Four Nazareth Academy seniors hold chart showing reading achievements of advanced reading classes.

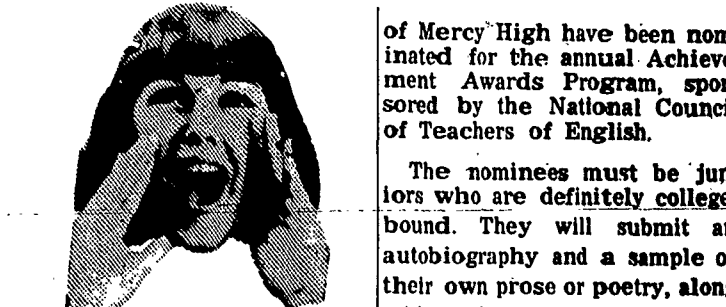
