## Eugene Tschiderer Rites Offered at St. Augustine's

Funeral Mass for Eugene J. Tschiderer was offered by his cousin, Father John M. Merklinger in St. Augustine's Church, June 4. Mr. Tschiderer died June 1, 1966.

Also in the sanctuary at the Requiem Mass were Monsignor John M. Duffy, Fathers John Regan and Robert Donovan, also a cousin of the deceased.

Mr. Tschiderer was a World War II Army Air Corps veteran. He was partially disabled since 1961 when, while instructing in brake-reaction tests at the Fire Academy on Scottsville Road, he was jarred from a fire truck. He suffered a left ankle injury that kept him from work and made it necessary for him to wear a brace. He was a Fire Bureau member for 20 years.

He was commander of the American Legion Slager Band Post from 1963 to 1964 and county vice commander in 1964-1965. Until a year ago he was scoutmaster of Boy Scout Troop 91 of St. Augustine's Church.

Mr. Tschiderer was a member of the American Legion's Voiture 111 of the 40 and 8, the Veterans of Foreign Wars and the Holy Name Society.

Surviving are his wife, Martha Stier Tschiderer; four sons, Paul E., Thomas A., Richard J. and Daniel J.; two daughters, Patricia A. and Margaret Mary; his parents, Frank and Veronica Tschiderer, six brothers, Gerard of St. Petersburg, Fla.; Charles and David of San Diego, Calif.; Philip, Richard and John of Rochester and a sister, Mrs. James (Mary Agnes) Lenhard of Rochester.
