

## Detroit Parishes To Pool Strengths

Detroit — (RNS) — Archbishop John F. Dearden has announced a unique program whereby "younger and more vigorous" Catholic parishes will be able to offer financial help and personal service to their inner-city counterparts.

"It is not normal or healthy in a Christian sense that parishes go their individual way without regard to the conditions of others," said Archbishop Dearden. "To be truly Catholic we need to be concerned not only with the life of our own parish, but with that of all the parishes of the archdiocese and of the Church throughout the world."

"Parishes that are younger and more vigorous are in a position to offer different types of help to older and declining parishes. The two areas in-

which our obligations of Christian charity can be best realized are in providing financial help and in offering personal service."

Under the program, contributions to poorer parishes from individuals, organizations, parishes and institutions will be pooled into a common fund. To insure equitable distribution, Archbishop Dearden proposed the establishment of a Home Mission Board to be composed initially of three priests and three laymen who will be chosen because of special interest and knowledge of the needs of older parishes.

Members will review the budgets of needy parishes and make specific recommendations to the archbishop for distribution of funds. The board will then ascertain that the funds are used for the purposes indicated.

"In order that all those who have a part in this work may have a sense of sharing, it is my thought also to have the board make an annual report to the pastors of the archdiocese, indicating the way in which funds were distributed in the course of the year," Archbishop Dearden continued. "They may then in some proper fashion communicate this to their people."

Financially strong parishes may make contributions to the

central fund of up to 10 per cent of their net income. One Detroit eastside parish already has made such a pledge.

"In addition to the financial help that is of such value to these older parishes," said Archbishop Dearden, "there is needed also an apostolate of personal service. The involvement of persons from other more secure parishes in the life and the activity of the older parishes is a two-fold blessing."

"Through such works as tutoring, counseling, ministrations to the sick and the poor, and in many other areas of personal involvement, an extraordinary opportunity is offered for the living expression of Christian charity."
