

### Clergy to Shun Mixed Rites

Stuttgart — (NC) — Protestant ministers in some areas of Germany have been banned by their churches from taking part in mixed marriage ceremonies in Catholic churches.

Protestant church officials claim that the presence of a minister at a mixed marriage indicates approval of the Catholic ceremony, and hence would be a violation of the minister's allegiance to his own denomination.

Both Protestant and Catholic authorities believe that the presence of the minister encourages mixed marriages, which neither group wants.

### Two Million From Schenley

New York — (NC) — Gifts totaling \$2.5 million to Catholic, Jewish and Protestant organizations of Lewis S. Rosentiel, chairman and president of Schenley, Industries, Inc., were reported here by Francis Cardinal Spellman.

Cardinal Spellman revealed the donations as the principal speaker at a dinner marking Rosentiel's 75th birthday.

Major gifts included \$800,000 to Brandeis University, Waltham, Mass., for continuing research in the field of biochemistry, \$400,000 to the Catholic archdiocese of New York, and \$800,000 to Catholic, Jewish and Protestant charities in California.

### On The Carpet in Rome, Dutch Priest Optimistic

Amsterdam — (NC) — A Dutch university chaplain who was several times in hot water under the old Holy Office in Rome returned here optimistic after being on the carpet of its successor, the Doctrinal Congregation.

Jesuit Father J. C. van Kilsdonk, moderator of the St. Thomas Aquinas students' union at the University of Amsterdam, had been summoned to Rome to discuss his recent articles in student publications on interpretation of the virgin birth of Christ and on the sense in which the divinity of Jesus should be understood. On the question of the virgin birth, the Jesuit had said in effect that its interpretation not be limited to a strictly biological view.

Under new procedures in line with Pope Paul's decree of last December, by which the Congregation of the Holy Office became the Doctrinal Congregation, Father van Kilsdonk was called to Rome and given the right to defend his views.

On return from his hearing by representatives of the Doctrinal Congregation — believed to be the first of its kind — Father van Kilsdonk said he was "not dissatisfied." The hearing was conducted, he said, by two consultants of the Doctrinal Congregation: Jesuit Father Edward Dhanis, Dutch-speaking Belgian who is rector of the Pontifical Gregorian University, and Reclonist Father Jan M. Visser, Dutch-born dean of the theological school of the Pontifical Urban University.

The Dutch Jesuit said the Rome talks lasted three full hours. He said that while Father Dhanis proved very strict, cold and unapproachable, Father Visser was open, straight,
