St. Bernard's Grad Chooses Vietnam

Danang — (NC) — A 26-year-old American has arrived here to begin a lifetime assignment as a priest of the Danang diocese.

He is Father Peter J. Singleton, of Rome, N.Y., who has been released for this purpose by his native diocese of Syracuse.

Father Singleton is studying the Vietnamese language and learning his new job as diocesan director of charities.

His interest in spending his priesthood here began at St. Bernard's Seminary, Rochester, where he met a Vietnamese seminarian, Dominic Mai Thanh Luong of the Danang diocese. Father Luong was ordained in Buffalo on May 21, the same day Father Singleton was ordained in Syracuse by Auxiliary Bishop David F. Cunningham of Syracuse. Later, he met another Vietnamese priest, Father Paul Huynh dong Cac of the Qui Nhon diocese, who was studying at the Catholic University of America, Washington, D.C.

Father Singleton became convinced of the need for priests in Vietnam. He sought permission for transfer to work in this area.

Seminarians To Cooperate

Indianapolis — (RNS) — Plans for establishment of a new Roman Catholic theological seminary that is expected to cooperate with a neighboring Protestant seminary were announced here.

The new school, to be established next fall, will be known as the Catholic Seminary of Indianapolis. Christian Theological Seminary, operated by the Christian Churches (Disciples of Christ) has offered to share classrooms, office space and other facilities with the projected Catholic school until the latter's building program can be completed. Each school will maintain its own faculty and administration, however.

Plans for further cooperation between the Protestant and Catholic schools are under consideration. The Catholic school is to be located on a 155-acre estate, about a ten-minute drive from the campus of Christian Theological Seminary, formerly known as Butler University School of Religion.

The initial group of students at the new seminary is expected to come from St. Maur's Seminary.

Advice from Vatican

Give Hearing To Seminarians

Baltimore — (RNS) — Seminary directors were urged to listen to the discontents then try to understand and help them.

The advice was offered by Archbishop Gabriel Garrone, prefect of the Sacred Congregation of Seminaries and Universities, who attended the 175th anniversary of the founding of St. Mary's Seminary here.

When asked to comment on the recent vocal expressions of discontent from seminarians, Archbishop Garrone said:

"It's a case of trying to lead them and help them attain the things they want. I believe very deeply from my own experience that I cannot pass a negative judgment on these young men in general. They must be listened to, and we must try to understand them and help them even though their conditions aren't always met."

Archbishop Garrone said he did not believe that there is basically a lack of obedience.

Poverty Racks Sudan Refugees

London — (RNS) — Nearly 4,000 refugees from the strife-torn Southern Sudan, mostly women and children and predominately Christians, are living in real poverty in the northeast Congo, according to a Roman Catholic leader who was interviewed during a short stay in London.

Msr. Lino Tibol normally administers the Rumbek Vicariate of the Southern Sudan, to which he was appointed by the Holy See in 1960, but he fled with the other refugees to the Congo last year.

He told of their plight here as he prepared to return to the Congo after visiting Rome to report on conditions in the Aba area, where the refugees are now living.

"We live in real poverty," he declared, "living in grass huts, sleeping on leaves. We have no blankets."

Most of the refugees are Christians, according to Msr. Tibol, but there are also Moslems and pagans. "They all work together to support each other," he added. "In fact, they all cooperated in building a small chapel at the settlement which is used by Catholics, Protestants and Moslems."

Many of the refugee children who fled to the Congo have died of malnutrition, he also said. No medical facilities are available and it is left to the able-bodied women to feed and support the many aged and infirm among the refugees.

Chaplain Dies In Ship Fire

Washington — (RNS) — The U.S. Navy announced here that Catholic Chaplain (Lt. Comdr.) William J. Garrity of Helena, Mont., was among 43 officers and enlisted men who died in a fire aboard the aircraft carrier Oriskany off the Vietnamese coast on Oct. 26.

Father Garrity, 40, had been the ship's Catholic chaplain since May, 1965. Commissioned in the Navy chaplaincy reserve corps in 1957, the priest had served on active duty since 1962. He had various assignments in this country before he became chaplain on the Oriskany.

The Navy announcement called Father Garrity a "most dedicated chaplain" and released text of a letter he had written the Navy Chief of Chaplains in 1961 after a two-week tour of active duty in San Diego, Calif.

Wrote Father Garrity: "I have nothing but praise for the chaplains now on active duty, and in the needs of the Church in this area were less pressing, I would be the first requesting immediate acceptance for active duty."
