

Differences—Wide as Ever Military Chaplains Seek Official Advisory Status



President
Mr. John Shields of Strong, Pa., was elected president of the National Council of Catholic Women at its 33rd biennial convention in Miami Beach. She succeeds Mrs. Marcus Kitch of Youngstown, Ohio. Theme of the meeting was "The New Pentecost, related to the effects of Vatican Council actions on the lives and apostolate of Catholic women. The NCCW is a federation of women's groups representing about 10 million members in this country and on overseas U.S. military installations.

New York — (RNS) — Despite growth of the dialogue, differences between Roman Catholics and Jews on both public and theological questions remain "as wide as ever," according to the American Jewish Congress.

It cited in particular the positions on birth control and public funds for parochial schools.

Howard M. Squadron, chairman of the Commission on Law and Social Action of the Congress, said he was "neither surprised nor disappointed" that closer ties had not produced fewer differences.

"Dialogue does not have to

result in agreement," Mr. Squadron said. "It does serve a useful purpose by exposing different points of view to rational exploration rather than emotional explosions."

He pointed out that it was "not unusual for Jews and Catholics to oppose each other at a public hearing on an issue of church-state separation in the morning and sit around a table the same evening in inter-faith dialogue."

"This is a healthy development. It is healthy that the two groups should meet together in civilized discourse and it is healthy that neither group should feel it must abandon

principles as the price of inter-faith harmony."

The question of public financing of church-related schools was termed one of the major differences between Catholics and Jews.

Conceding that some Orthodox bodies in the Jewish community had joined Catholics in seeking federal and state funds for parochial schools and Yeshivah, Mr. Squadron said:

"The overwhelming majority of American Jews — as represented by the secular and religious organizations that speak for them — strongly oppose any weakening of the wall of separation between church and state."

Washington — (RNS) — Two executives of chaplains' commissions have expressed hope that in the near future the Department of Defense will consent to establishment of an advisory Commission to the Secretary of Defense on the Chaplaincy.

Such a group, said A. Ray Applequist, executive secretary of the General Commission on Chaplains and Armed Forces Personnel, would advise the Secretary of Defense on vital matters relating to the chaplaincy and to religion and morality in the armed forces.

As he envisions the advisory group, it would have stated

regular meetings and a definite organizational structure with official status.

Mr. Applequist, whose civilian religious agency is the largest of any in the U.S., representing 36 Protestant denominations and supplying approximately 1,600 chaplains for the services, said there is much justification for such a commission of experts.

"The chaplaincy has gotten so much more comprehensive than it was in World War II," he said. "There are so many more aspects of it than there were in the past."
