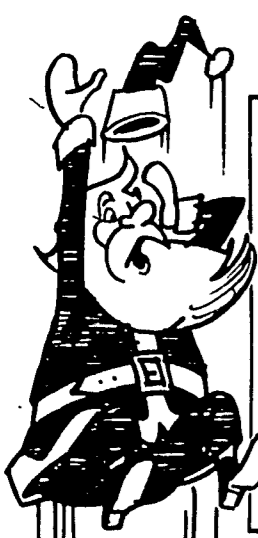

Members of the organization are carrying on a vigorous campaign in an effort to make the Christmas season a more joyous and thankful occasion for some families who are underprivileged.

Tony Gammaro, son of Mr. and Mrs. Andy Gammaro, 291 Sunset Dr. Corning, and president of the organization, remarked, "This drive is giving many students the opportunity to learn and appreciate the true meaning of Christmas."

Religion Study For Adults

"Sex, Family and Society" and "The Ministry of Relationships: Iguanas on Verandahs—Broken Gates between Persons" will be the winter semester courses offered by the Rochester Area Council of Churches School of Religion on January 3, 10, 17, 24 and 31 at Colgate Rochester Divinity School.

Dr. J. C. Wynn, a specialist in family education and Director of Studies at Colgate Rochester Divinity School, will conduct the first course, which will take a critical look at the contemporary family and some of its common problems as seen in a theological focus.

The associate pastor of Brick Presbyterian Church, Rochester, Rev. Bruce E. Billman, will be the instructor of the latter course to be based on Scriptures, Tennessee Williams play, "The Night of the Iguana," "Life Together," by Dietrich Bonhoeffer and "The Rule of Taizé."

To register for these courses, write to the Christian Education Department, Rochester Area Council of Churches, 328 Granite Building, Rochester.

Formal registration will take place on Monday, Jan. 9 at 7 p.m. at the Main Street Annex. Additional non-resident tuition fee of \$20 is required for students who live outside of the city.

New Edition Of 'All Day With God'

A collection of prayers, revised in accordance with the latest liturgical changes and compiled by a local author is out just in time for last-minute holiday gift giving.

"All Day with God," by Blanche Jennings Thompson, well-known for her books on religious subjects, contains numerous folk-prayers as well as those of a more traditional bent. Among the former are the Prayer of an Old Irish Woman, An Old French Prayer, and A Prayer to Our Lady of Labor.

OF SPECIAL NOTE is Miss Thompson's "A Catholic Philosophy" which acts as a preface to the collection. In setting our thinking straight on the Church's attitude on prayer in the light of liturgical change she notes that "It is not the intention of the Church to discourage private prayer except

when it interferes with the Catholic's full participation in that corporate worship which has been restored to its proper place in Christian life. Instead of remaining quiet and preoccupied with their rosaries or with personal prayer, the People of God are asked to share with the priest in offering the Holy Sacrifice and to raise their heart's and voices in hymns of praise and thanksgiving."

Selections from "The Imitation of Christ," up-to-date prayers for the Liturgy of the Eucharist, and prayers for different professions round out this slim volume which may be purchased at local religious book stores for \$3.75.

Miss Thompson has long been a teacher in the Rochester school system and most recently was a faculty member at the University of Rochester. She is the author of numerous books,

the most notable of which are "Silver Pennies" and those in the Vision Series, particularly "St. Elizabeth's Three Crowns."

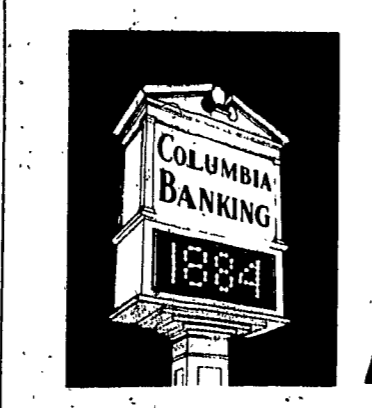
