New Self-Care Unit Open At St. Mary's Hospital

St. Mary's Hospital opened its new \$250,000 self-care unit last week bringing the hospital's capacity to 318 beds and making it the city's third largest hospital. The unit is to be called Seton Hospice, the name "Seton" for Elizabeth Ann Seton, the American foundress of the daughters of Charity, the order of nuns who operate St. Mary's Hospital, and "Hospice," a French word meaning an overnight lodging, usually operated by religious.

Despite the elegant surroundings, patients in Seton Hospice will pay less for their rooms. Because fewer personnel are required to staff the unit, costs will be lower than surgical, medical, or obstetrical units. The 24 beds in Seton Hospice are arranged in 16 private rooms and 4 two-bedrooms, all with their own bathrooms and showers. Walls facing the outside of the hospital are wood paneled and the other walls are painted blue, green or yellow.

The purpose of the unit is to provide facilities for ambulatory and physically self-sufficient patients who require therapeutic or diagnostic services which must be performed in the hospital, or who need one or two days of additional instruction in the management of their illness. The unit will utilize personnel to the fullest extent by reducing or increasing the personnel in accordance with patients' needs.

Admissions to the unit may be doctors' orders only, either by outside reservations or by transfer from other units within the hospital.

Criteria for admission are: 1. The patient must be able to give himself complete personal care; 2. He must be able to take all meals in the dining room. It is expected that some of the patients will be diabetic patients who need instruction and supervision in diet and insulin therapy. Possibly other patients who are admitted for elective surgery or pre-surgical tests may use the unit and later be transferred to a surgical floor.
