United States foreign policy will be the topic, and one hundred of the top collegiate debaters from the eastern half of the nation will be the speakers in the 13th Annual Fisher Forum Debate Tournament at St. John Fisher College, Feb. 3 and 4.

Four-man teams of varsity orators from 24 colleges will discuss the topic "Resolved: That the United States should substantially reduce its foreign policy commitments" in five rounds of debate.

Father John S. Maloney, who has served as administrator of the Immaculate Conception Church, Ithaca, since 1960, was named pastor there this week by Bishop Sheen. He succeeds Monsignor William Byrne who died early this month and had been in retirement the past several years. Father Maloney, a chaplain during World War II, holds many distinctions for outstanding service, including the Distinguished Service Cross and was voted a member of the Legion of Valor in 1964.

B. L. Keenen Dies in Erie

Bernard L. Keenen, former district manager of the Social Security Administration's Rochester office, died Friday, Jan. 6, 1967 in a hospital in Erie, Pa. He was 75.

In Rochester, he was vice president of the Notre Dame Retreat League, on the board of the YMCA Athletic Club, a member of the Rochester Council of Social Agencies Section on the Aged. He resided at 50 Chestnut St. and attended St. Mary's Church.

Mr. Keenen was born in Ridgeway, Pa., and joined the SSA in 1937. He opened the offices in Erie, Pa., and was later assigned as district manager to offices in Erie, Pittsburgh, Perth Amboy, N.J., and New York.

He came to Rochester in 1953 and retired in 1961 when he moved to Erie, last September.
