Funeral Mass for Frank J. Hanna, brother of two priests was offered by Father Bernard C. Hanna with Father Austin B. Hanna in St. Augustine's Church, Saturday, Jan. 28.

Mr. Hanna, 62, formerly of 59 Wellington Ave., a World War II veteran and retired Rochester Post Office clerk died Jan. 25, 1967 in Ann Lee Hospital, Albany.

A native of Rochester, Mr. Hanna was a graduate of Cathedral grammar and Cathedral High Schools. He was a surveyor for the city before going to the Post Office.

The two priest-brothers of Mr. Hanna are Father Austin B. chaplain of St. Joseph's Villa, 3300 Dewey Ave. and Father Bernard C., chaplain of the Dominican Convent in Elmira.

He retired three years ago because of illness and was admitted to Veterans Hospital in Albany.

Also surviving are three brothers, Edward, Williamsonville, N.Y., retired United States chief probation and parole officer for the Justice Department in Western New York; Brighton Peace Justice Thomas F. Hanna; and Adrian M. Hanna, a member of the industrial relations staff in Eastman Kodak Company's Apparatus and Optical Division, and one sister, Mrs. Nagim (Margaret) Chercralah, Springfield, Mass., several
