Yesterday (Feb. 2) marked the official opening of the Congress at the Buenos Aires Cathedral, followed by a dance and get-acquainted evening. The next few days will be devoted to the usual business of a convention with delegation reports. A feature of the week will be a formal ball with international folk dancing and singing featured at the Buenos Aires auditorium. The official closing is scheduled for Feb. 7 at the cathedral.

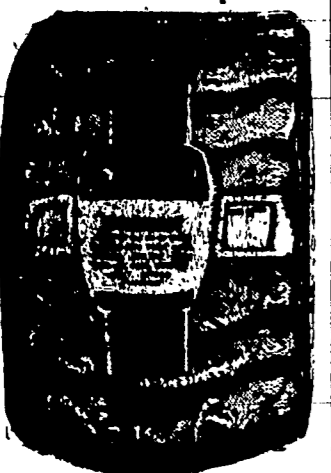
