Funeral Mass for John F. Judge, Sr. was offered by Monsignor Leo V. Smith in Our Lady of Good Counsel Church, Tuesday, Jan. 31. Mr. Judge, 64, of 843 Genesee Park Blvd., President and part owner of Colprovia Pavements, Inc., died Jan. 28, 1967.

He came to Rochester in 1920 and was a civil engineering graduate of the Mechanics Institute.

Mr. Judge was a member of Our Lady of Good Counsel, Men's Club, Rochester Council, Knights of Columbus and Rochester General Assembly. Four children.
