Young Musicians Receive Top Awards

A 15-year-old pianist and a 17-year-old soprano have been named the winners, respectively, in this year competition for the Albright and Deverian Awards for Young Artists.

The pianist, John Cook, is 15 and a sophomore at McQuaid Jesuit High School. Winner of the Albright Award, he is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Jerome C. Cook of 1894 Highland Avenue. The Deverian Award went this year to 17-year-old Susan Goldman, soprano. She is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Albert E. Goldman, 142 Penarow Road, Brighton, and a senior at Brighton High School.

The Albright Award is presented annually by the Rochester Civic Music Association to the outstanding high school student instrumentalist of the area. Named in memory of Raymond W. Albright, a past president of the CMA, the prize carries with it a \$100 Savings Bond and an appearance as soloist with the Rochester Philharmonic Orchestra in the Youth Membership Concert on April 6.

The Deverian Award goes annually to the outstanding high school vocal soloist, and is presented by the Women's Committee of the CMA in memory of Mrs. Robert V. Deverian, (a past president of the committee). The winner receives a \$50 Savings Bond. In addition, Miss Goldman has been invited this year to appear as soloist at the Women's Committee annual meeting in May.
