Mt. Carmel Art Show Scheduled for April 23

Auburn — Third Annual Art Show of Mount Carmel High School will be held in Auburn, Sunday, April 23. Theme of the show will be "The Jewish Religion and Traditions," according to Father Regis-Broniszewski, O. Carm., art show director.

Each contestant from among the student body is asked to submit at least one entry on a Biblical or Jewish theme. Three prizes will be awarded to the three best entries from students of the school for whom the show is principally held. Father Regis said it is hoped that having such an event will stimulate the artistic talents of the students. Mt. Carmel is the only school in Auburn that has an annual art show.

Special feature will be the exhibition of art-work by the inmates of Auburn Prison to be shown through the cooperation of Warden J. Edwin LaVallee and John Griffin, art director in the prison. The works of the inmates will be on sale during the show.

This year's theme was chosen because Passover occurs close to the day of the show and as an ecumenical gesture of good will to the Jewish community of Auburn. Rabbi Michael Kurz will be consulted and the help of the Jewish people of this city used, in carrying out the show's theme.
