

## Mooney Wins 57-43 Decision

Cardinal Mooney basketball team marched to the semifinals of the Diocesan Tournament as it topped a good St. Anthony quintet by a score of 57-43. The score did not indicate the closeness of the game as the hustling Castadors of Padua came within three points, 33-30, with two minutes left in the 3rd period. The win was number 15 for Mooney against 4 losses.

The Cardinals led 23-11 at the end of the first period with Otis Davis tossing in 8 points and sophomore Dick Felber 6 to pace Mooney. They kept their advantage to 29-19 at the half, way mark as Davis threw in 4 more points. Padua drew closer to the Cardinals as it received

a boost of 7 points from hot shooting John Opiola. A three point play by Davis, however, broke the back of the Cardinals. They roared back to lead 40-30 at the end of the 3rd stanza.

Davis led Mooney with 28 points while sophomore Doug Farrell had 12. Opiola paced Padua with 19 points. The Cardinals top scorer Jim Harrington was held to 2 points for his lowest output of the season. Harrington, however, led the rebounders by pulling down 14 rebounds.

## DeSales Downs Aquinas 62-60

DeSales High of Geneva, despite a 29 scoring output by Aquinas' Jim Murawski, moved into the semi-final round of the Diocesan Tournament last Sunday afternoon by means of a 62-60 double overtime victory at the expense of defending tournament champion Aquinas of Rochester.

After falling behind a Murawski-moved Aquinas team at the half, the Saints from Geneva opened the second half by ripping off thirteen consecutive points and thereby taking a 33-23 lead.

Aquinas pulled within a point at 50-49 with less than forty seconds remaining.

Fifteen seconds were remaining when DeSales made the first, then missed the second, foul shot in a one-or-one situation. The Aquinas combination of a Pete McGuire rebound, a Paul Flore assist, and a Dan Hogan layup tied the score at 51-51.

In the first overtime, DeSales took leads of 53-51, 55-53, and 57-55 on Bill Dinan jump shots. However, Aquinas' Dick Barron knotted the score at 57-57.

In the second overtime, the Saints took the lead once again, this time for keeps, as Steve Fitzgerald and Mike Roulan scored from the field to give DeSales a 61-57 lead and the victory.

Aquinas senior Jim Murawski was the game's leading scorer with 29 points. Murawski's point production was the highest individual Aquinas game total since the 1963-64 season.
