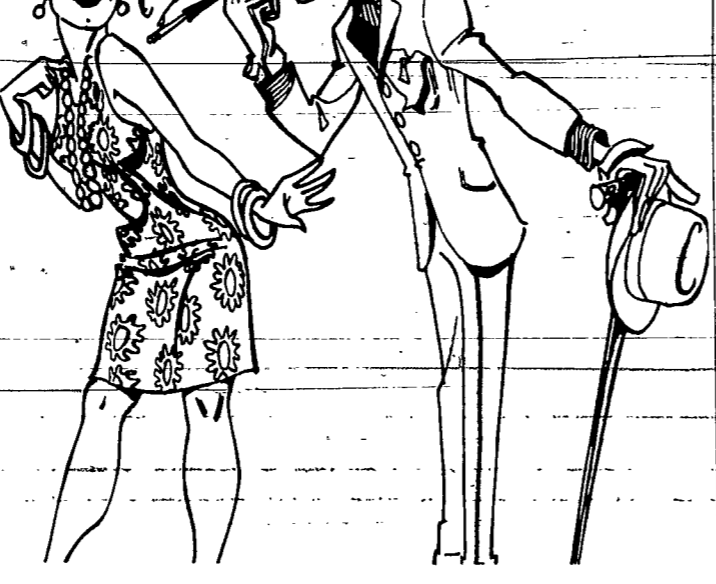
The three one-act plays by Pirandello are: "Chee Chee," "The Man With The Flower In His Mouth," and "The Jar."

Bishop's Company Drama To be Staged at Mooney

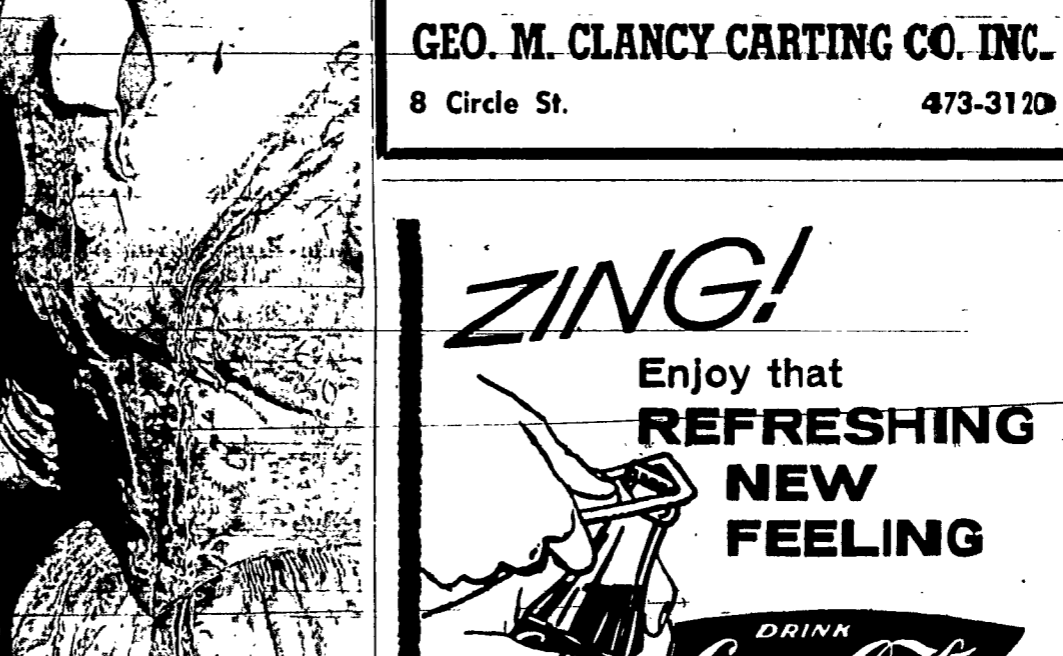

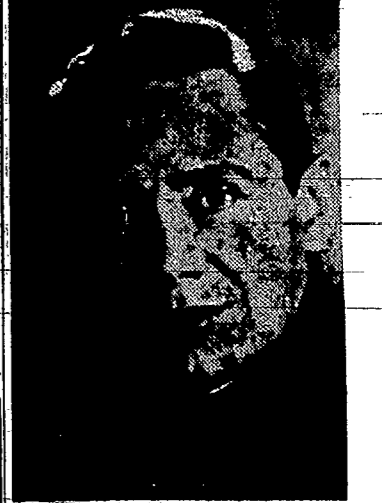
