## Father Joseph Muckle, Noted Basilian, 14 Requiem Offered by Toronto Prelate

Solemn Pontifical Funeral Mass for Father Joseph T. Muckle, C.S.B., noted Basilian educator and formerly of Stanley, N.Y., was offered in St. Basil's Church, Toronto by Archbishop Phillip F. Pocock, Saturday, May 13.

Father Muckle, 80, of Toronto, died Tuesday, May 9, 1967 in Fort Lauderdale, Fla. He had been ill for many years.

He was born in Middlesex, N.Y. Jan. 22, 1887, the son of Thomas Muckle and Margaret Delaney Muckle. He attended school in Penn Yan, East High School, Rochester and St. Michael's college, Toronto. He entered the novitiate of the Congregation of St. Basil in 1907 and made his first profession, Aug. 15, 1908.

## Mrs. Mary Fischette Mass Offered by Priest-Son

A concelebrated Funeral Mass for Mrs. Mary Fischette was offered by her son, Father Robert M. Fischette, C.S.B., of Toronto, Canada in St. Charles Borromeo Church, Greece, Monday, May 13.

Concelebrants with Father Fischette were Monsignor Robert A. Keleher, and Reverend Fathers Raymond Prince, Cyril Carter, Leo Klem, all Basilians. Father Michael Murphy was master of ceremonies.

Mrs. Fischette of Bayberry Lane who was also mother of a missionary nun in Africa died May 10, 1967.

Also attending the Funeral Mass were Right Reverend Monsignors Arthur F. Ratican, John P. Duffy, Richard K. Burns and 32 other priests.

Surviving are her husband, Rocco M. Fischette; her daughter, Sister Pierre, S.S.P., of Accra, Ghana, Africa; five sons.

## Miss Morrison Last Rites Held

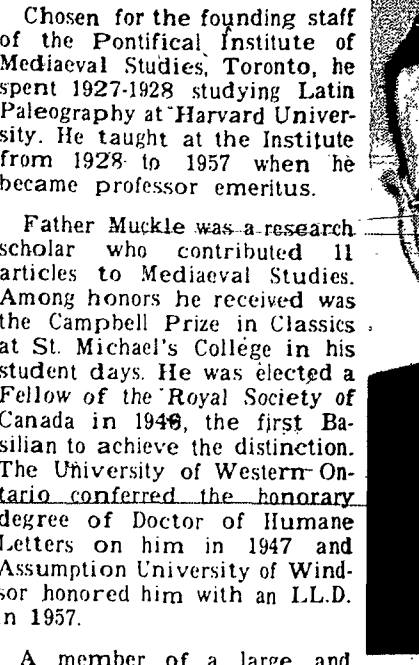
Funeral Mass for Margaret C. Morrison was offered in St. Monica's Church by Father Gerald E. Dunn, May 8. Miss Morrison of 83 Winbourne Rd., 69, a 44-year employee of General Railway Signal Co., died May 5, 1967.

She was a member of St. Monica's Rosary Society.

Born in Lindsay, Ontario, she came to Rochester as an infant with her parents, Mr. and Mrs. James S. Morrison.

She attended Immaculate Conception School.

Surviving are her niece, Mrs. Jack (Dorothy) Greene; one grandnephew, Jeff Greene of the U.S. Army of Fort Huachuca, Arizona; one grandniece, Miss Nancy Greene; two cousins, Mrs. Gladys Winter and Donald Cunningham.



Chosen for the founding staff of the Pontifical Institute of Mediaeval Studies, Toronto, he spent 1927-1928 studying Latin Paleography at Harvard University. He taught at the Institute from 1928 to 1957 when he became professor emeritus.

Father Muckle was a research scholar who contributed 11 articles to Mediaeval Studies. Among honors he received was the Campbell Prize in Classics at St. Michael's College in his student days. He was elected a Fellow of the Royal Society of Canada in 1948, the first Basilian to achieve the distinction. The University of Western Ontario conferred the honorary degree of Doctor of Humane Letters on him in 1947 and Assumption University of Windsor honored him with an LL.D. in 1957.

A member of a large and distinguished family he is only survived by one brother, Andrew of Stanley, several nephews and nieces in Rochester and one in Syracuse.

Three other brothers, all priests, Father William of Toronto, Father John Muckle of St. Thomas the Apostle Church, Avon, predeceased him as did Leo Muckle formerly of Rochester and Ithaca. Three sisters also deceased were Sister Mary Charles of the Sisters of Mercy, Rochester; Mrs. Jane McWilliams and Mrs. Mary McWilliams.
