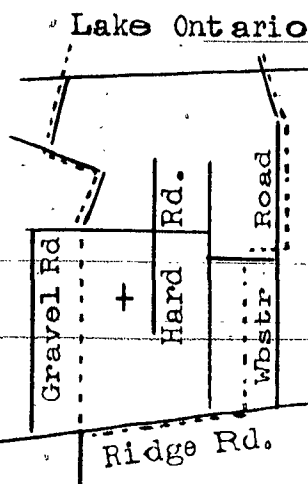


Boundaries For St. Paul's

Pressure Mounts on Pupil Aid

What would you think if a law said you have a right to walk left or right... and if you walk left, the government will send a bus so you can ride, it will feed you, provide you books and buildings, guides and entertainers... but if you walk to the right, the government will clobber you.

That, in effect, is the present New York State constitutional law about your child's right to go to either a public or a parochial school.

New York City's World Journal Tribune, in one of its last editions, reported there is enough strength among delegates to overturn the law and write a new one that will assure a fair share of State school aid for all pupils.

There are, however, some hazards.

Many delegates report they're receiving an avalanche of letters urging them to retain the present 1894 "Blaine Amendment" law which bans all but fringe benefits to parochial school children.

Letters to editors in area newspapers also indicate a strong organized effort to block any updating of the State's Constitution.

Parents would do well to make themselves articulate on the subject or their November efforts can be swamped by the present stepped-up campaign to "clobber" parochial pupils.
